A study visit to NIO (NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF OCEANOGRAPHY)

On 24th August 2022, the T.Y. students of the department of Biochemistry along with Dr. Aduja Naik and Ms. Lisha Da Costa visited the CSIR-NIO (Council of Scientific and Industrial Research – National Institute of Oceanography situated at Dona Paula, Goa. At the outset, the museum was visited where various instruments for ocean studies were displayed. Various coral and fossils were on display. The PCR and RT-PCR techniques were demonstrated at Dr. Rakhi Kandeparkar's laboratory at the biological oceanography section of NIO. The students observed instruments such as Nano drop spectrophotometer, HPLC, etc. The trip concluded with the movie depicting the origin, history and activities of NIO.



Visit to Paul John Distillery

The trip to Paul John was a field trip under their SEC course – Food and Fermentation Technology on 22nd October 2022. The distillery was set up in Cuncolim, where we were given an informative talk to help us understand how the distillery worked, why Goa was a good place to set up their distillery and how they made use of marketing strategies to make the sale of Paul John branded products sell more. After watching the whole process of how the grains were converted to alcoholic products, the process of ageing was explained which worked differently according to environmental conditions. The trip was efficient in teaching us how alcohol was mass produced and marketed.


