SCORING CRITERIA FOR ADVITIYA NETRUTVA

The scoring criteria for the Advitiya Netrutva initiative, is designed to recognize all-round performances by students. As such, the final scores are calculated across five sections with the following weightage for each:

• Academics: 30

• Extra-curricular: 30

Sports: 20NCC: 10

• Volunteer Work: 10

The process of calculating the final score is as follows

- 1) For each section, enter the points for each criteria separately
- 2) Calculate the weighted percentage for the section using the weightage given. This will provide the Section Score (see scoring template with examples at the end of the table)
- 3) Add all the Section Scores to obtain an Overall Score out of 100

For First Year students achievements from XIth class onwards will be used to calculate the scores. For other students the previous two years achievements will be considered. May note that achievements of Secondary schooling and below are not to be considered for the calculation of points.

Eligibility requirement: Please note that only those students who are enrolled for AY 2023-24 and DO NOT have any current backlogs in any previous examinations are eligible to apply for the Advitiya Netrutva Initiative.
