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


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UGC-NET Workshop

The Department of Geography and Research Centre organized a workshop on "PrepSmart: Effective Strategies for UGC-NET and Other Competitive Exams Success" on 01st February, 2024. The resource person was Mr. Ashutosh Yadav, Assistant Professor in Geography. He discussed on how to acquire the knowledge needed to ace a variety of competitive exams and how taking such examinations help candidates advance in their careers. To give the students an idea of the kinds of questions that are asked for these examinations, he has also solved previous year's UGC-NET exam papers. In addition, Radhika Dhuri, an M.A. Geography Part II student who successfully cleared the UGC-NET exam in Geography (December, 2023), recounted her experiences and the challenges she faced in clearing the exam. A total of 18 students comprising of M.A. Geography Part I and II attended the workshop.

The resource person was Prof. (Dr.) Nandkumar Sawant, Head and Professor in the Department of Geography. He described how to organize the final year projects and dissertations. He focused on page and text requirements, body of content, tables, figures, and captions. He also emphasized the value and efficacy of research projects. Dr. Adrian Ferro led the second session, which focused on academic integrity and its value in research. This session was attended by the final year students of B.A and M.A. Geography.
