
**CIRCULAR**

It has been observed by the Scrutiny Committee of the Bursary Scheme that several applications have been forwarded by the institutions which were not at all verified by the concerned Head of the institution as required under the norms of the Bursary Scheme. In some cases, the Bonafide certificate was signed without filling the required details therein. There were applications with incomplete documents, which are necessary to determine the eligibility of the student to avail benefit under this scheme, which ultimately hampers the process of implementation a lot.

It was also noticed that the forms were submitted without proper verification from ~~the head of the institutions.~~

In view of above, all the Heads of the institution are instructed to follow the following guidelines before submitting the forms under the Bursary Scheme:

1. Income certificates submitted by students along with their form should be checked by the Head of the Department of the Institution during verification of the Application form.
2. Any other scholarship received by the student should be mentioned in the respective column.
3. The Bonafide certificate part of the form should be duly filled and signed by the Head of the institution.
4. Proper verification of all the documents submitted to the GEDC should be done by the Head of the Institute.
5. The complete Annexures in soft copy as well as hard copy duly stamped and signed in needs to be submitted while submitting application forms.
6. Non submission of necessary documents that decide the eligibility criteria, will be out- rightly rejected e.g Income Certificate/unemployment affidavit/mark sheets etc.

I am directed to inform you that, in view of the ongoing pandemic and prevailing extra ordinary difficult circumstances, the Government of Goa has decided that only for this Academic year 2021-2022, the Bursary Scheme shall also be made applicable to course/programme fees which exceed Rs. 60,000/- per annum for all the Institutes availing Bursary Scheme. However the maximum amount of grant given under this scheme will be restricted to Rs. 40,000/- per annum.
