Special Ordinance SO-2, Special Examination, in view of the Covid pandemic for the B.A./B.Sc./B.VOC./M.A./M.Sc. students who have not obtained the Under/Post Graduate Degree

- In view of the covid pandemic, students enrolled in the academic years mentioned in the Column No.2 but not earned the minimum number of credits required for award of Degrees, shall be permitted to register for similar courses for equivalent credits and complete their Degree upto the academic year indicated in Column No. 3/4 below :

- However, only those candidates who have completed all the requirements of the course/kept the terms and are otherwise eligible to appear for exam but could not appear due to "double the duration rule", will be allowed to register and appear for Examinations in the respective Semesters.
- Exams shall be conducted in the physical (offline) mode only.



Notification for Special Examination (B.A./B.Sc./B.VOC./M.A./M.Sc.)

With reference to the above ordinance, the College shall grant a special examination to the candidates having backlogs to appear for examination and complete the Programme, beyond double the duration subject to the following conditions:

1. Only those Under Graduate candidates who were admitted in the Academic Years 2017-2018 & 2018-2019 will be allowed to appear for Continuous Assessments (CA), Semester End Examinations (SEE), Practical Assessments and Project Assessment and

Only those Post Graduate candidates who were admitted in the Academic Year 2019-2020 & 2020-2021 will be allowed to appear for Continuous Assessments (CA), Semester End Examinations (SEE), Practical Assessments and Project Assessment.

2. Only those candidates who have completed/kept the terms and are otherwise eligible to appear for exam but could not appear due to “double the duration rule”, will be allowed to appear.

3. Candidates who have completed all the requirements of the course but could not obtain a degree due to failure in one or more course(s) will be allowed to appear.

4. Payment of fees shall be done only after the approval by the Examination Cell and the Principal of the institution.

5. B.A./B.Sc/B.VOC. Semester II/IV/VI exams & M.A./M.Sc. Semester II/IV exams to be held from January 2025 to May 2025 and B.A./B.Sc/B.VOC. Semester I/III/V exams & M.A./M.Sc. Semester I/III exams to be held from July 2025 to November 2025(Tentative) along with regular examinations.

6. The examinations shall be conducted in offline / physical mode only.



7. Students who would like to answer the special examination shall report to the Examination Cell on any one of the days from Tuesday, 7th January 2025 to Friday, 10th January 2025, between 10.00am and 11.00am along with the Semester I/II/III/IV/V/VI mark sheets issued by the institution.
