


The Mentor Mentee Meet for B.Sc. Biotechnology students was conducted on 26th November 2021 to resolve their issues and motivate them towards career goals.

Alumni talk series were conducted for experience sharing and guidance for the Biotechnologists in the making by the following proud alumni of our department;


