- The poem must be typed in Times New Roman, with a font size of 12.
- Use of vulgar and inappropriate language is prohibited.
- The final entry should be mailed to the respective student in charge in pdf format on or before 2nd December 2021 5 p.m.
- Name your file in the following format: Name, roll number, Class, Language, IDPD, and competition (eg. CarlYung_AU190211_TYBA_Eng_IDPD_PoetryWriting)
- The participants are free to use any style of poetry; interpret the given topics and title the poem as per their will.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

- If the participant wishes, a write-up explaining their idea behind the poster in about 100-150 words can also be attached separately with the poster.
- Name your file in the following format: Name, roll number, Class, IDPD, and competition (Eg. CarlYung_AU190211_TYBA_IDPD_PosterMaking)
- The participants are free to interpret the topics in their own way.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
