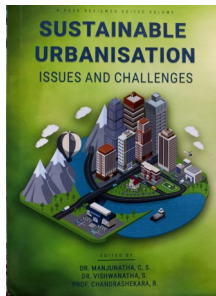

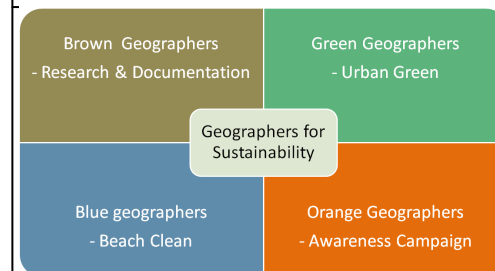


EDITORIAL
