The Khorana Program will provide opportunities to Indian students to undertake research at leading U.S. universities over Summer 2023 for a period of 10-12 weeks.

## The Khorana Program is envisaged to:

- Provide an opportunity to Indian students to gain exposure and access to world class research facilities
- Promote research and capacity building in frontline areas of biotechnology
- Encourage post-graduate students to take up research as a career
- Pave the way for the next generation of scientists and technologists towards building long-term sustainable R&D linkages and collaborations

## Eligibility:

- Pre-final year students enrolled in B.Tech., M. Tech., MSc., B.E., M.E., M.S., Integrated B.S-M.S., B.Sc., B.V.Sc., M.V.Sc., B. Pharm., M. Pharm., MBBS., and Master in Medical Science and Technology (MMST) at recognized institutions of higher education in India in Biotechnology and allied areas are eligible to apply.
- First Year, Final Year and Ph.D. students are NOT eligible to apply.
