e-launch of the CC@60 Logo

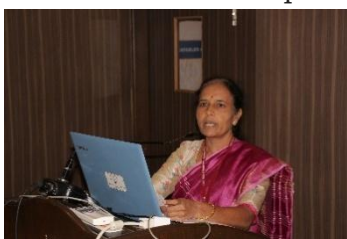

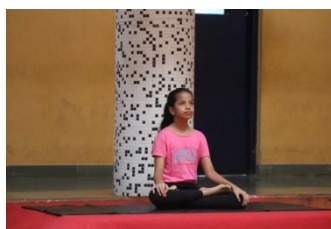

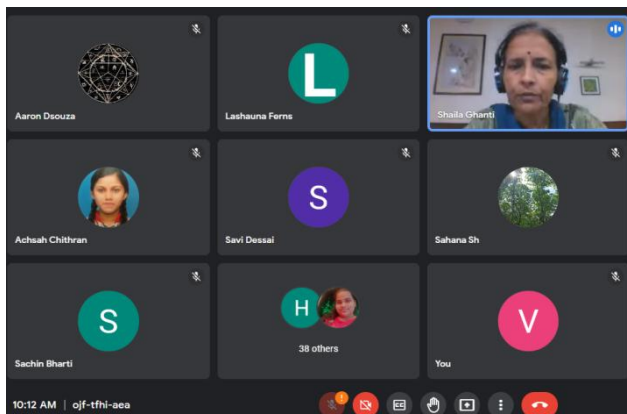

3) Department of Geography

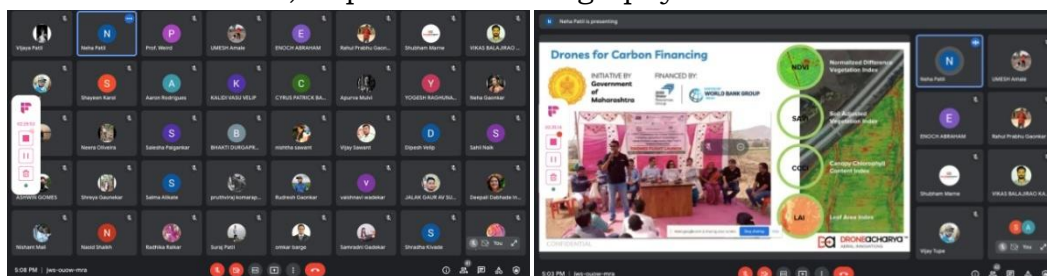
