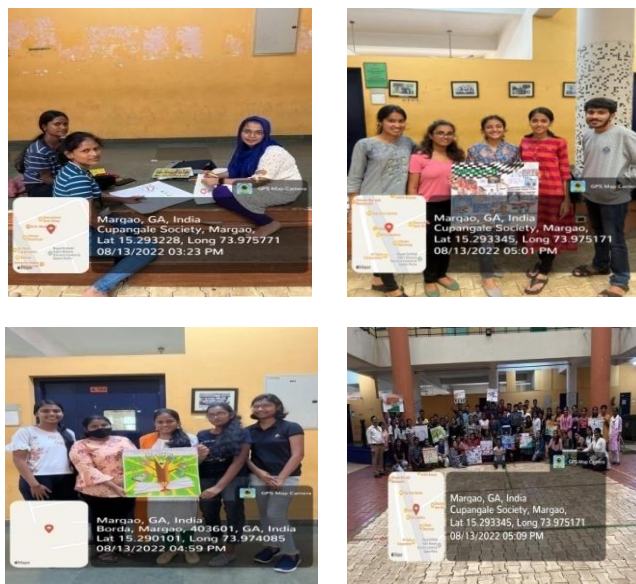

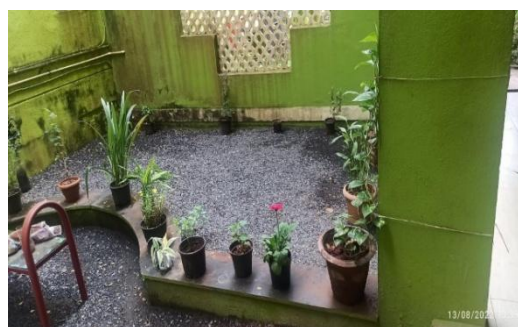

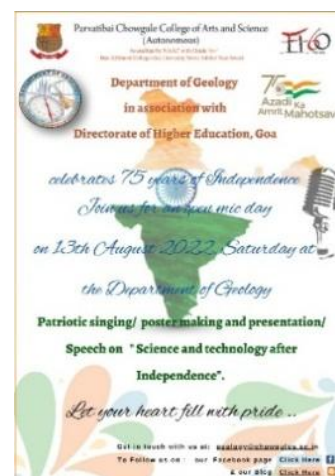

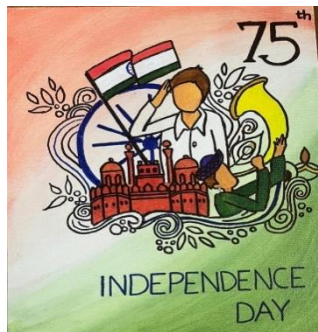

d) Independence Day Quiz Competition

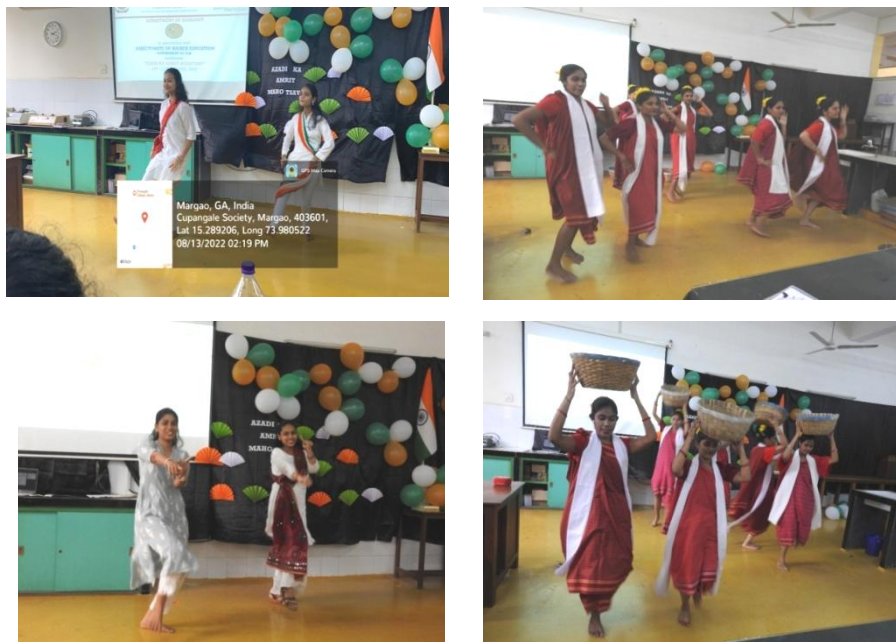

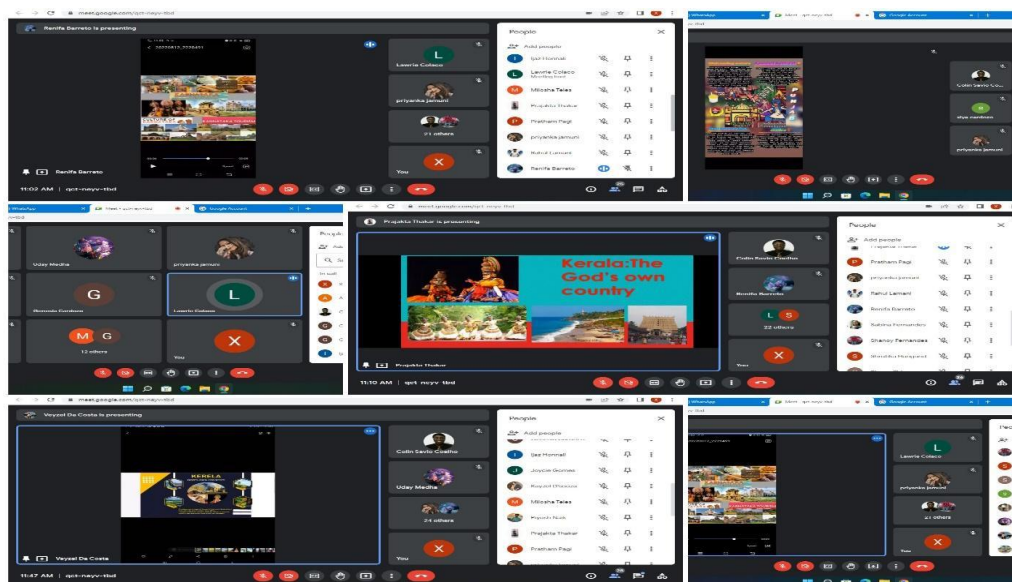

- Horrors of Partition Remembrance Day

“Horrors of Partition Remembrance Day” was organized by the Horrors of Partition Remembrance Day, Committee Members on 14th August, 2022 in the presence of the students and faculty in the College. The objective of this programme was to analyze the horrors that caused pain and suffering that took place during the Partition of India. The gathering was welcomed by Dr. Sachin Moraes, Convener of the event, Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.

Dr. Gunaji S. Desai, Convener, Horror of Partition Remembrance Day introduced the speaker Mrs. Sarita Naik Tari, Head & Associate Professor, Department of History. She delivered a talk on the topic “Partition of India and Aftermath” and highlighted the varied struggle of the people during the partition especially women and children and the atrocities committed against them in the camps. She mentioned the horrors of migrants and killings on the train.

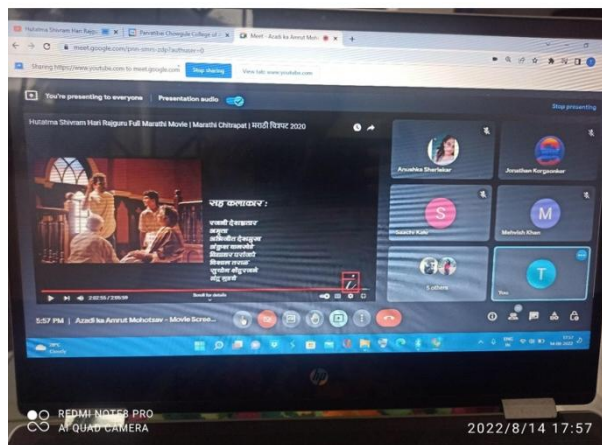

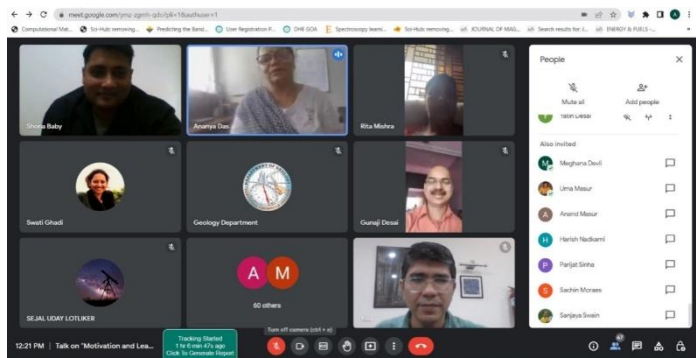

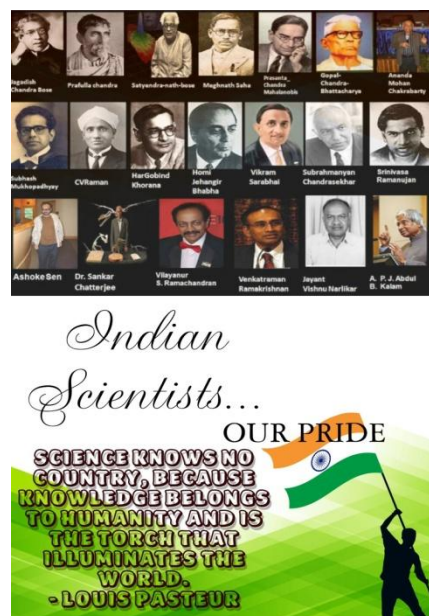

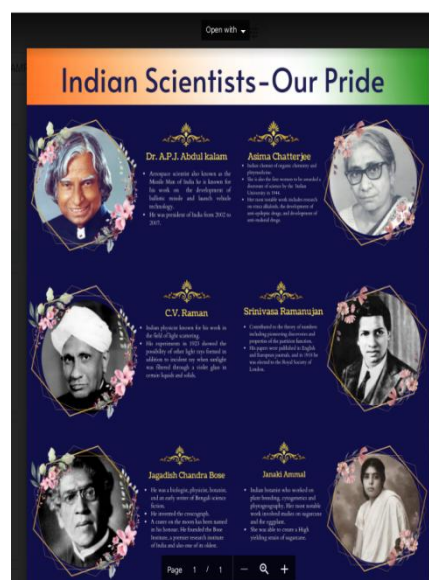

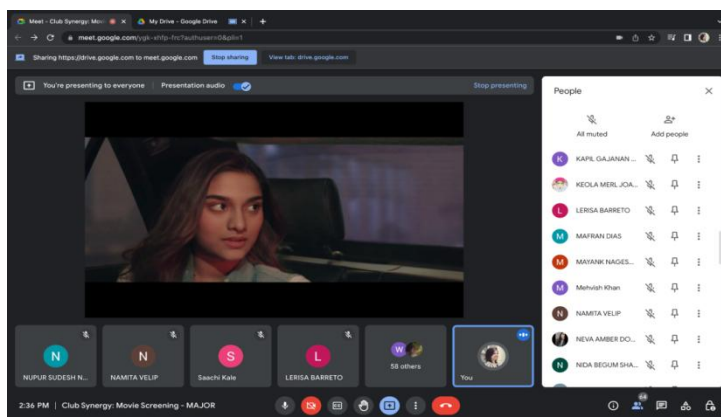
