 - c) *'Great Backyard Bird Count'* organized at Handi Khuris, Maina-Curtorim wetlands on 18th February, 2024.







Mr. Nathan associated with Christ (Deemed to be) University, Bangalore, provided students with information about the courses offered and the scope of Neuropsychology in India.


