Inauguration of Community Outreach Programme as part of CC@60

In commemoration of its six decades of noble service to society, Parvatibai Chowgule College of Arts and Science (Autonomous), Margao in collaboration with Camorlim Village Panchayat, South Goa inaugurated its Community Outreach Programme on 24 November 2022 at the Camorlim Village Panchayat premises. As a part of this Outreach Programme, the college commenced 'E-Granthalaya,' an e-library initiative that will help the village panchayat to digitally identify and access books from its library. This unique initiative will result in symbiotic benefits to the village community along with the Chowgule College students. The entire project is funded by the Chowgule Education Society and will be executed by the staff and students of Chowgule College under the aegis of Chowgule College at 60 (CC@60).
