

The Last Visit to the Old Age Home

The students from the HUMAN-Dosto Club of ParvatibaiChowgule College Arts and Science, Department of Sociology, visited the Nazareth Home for the Elderly in Navelim on 25th February 2025, from 4:30 pm to 5:40 pm. A total of 13 students participated in the visit. Assistant Professor, Ms. Mamta Kavlekar accompanied the students.

This visit was the last visit at the old age home for this academic year. As a token of appreciation and care, the students distributed hampers and groceries.
