#### 1. Chairman's Welcome

The Chairman, Dr. N. N. Sawant, welcomed all the members of the newly constituted academic council. He informed the members that as per the UGC guidelines, an Academic Council should have all Heads of Departments, four teachers of the College representing different categories of teaching staff, (by rotation on the basis of seniority of service in the College), five nominees of the Governing Body (experts from outside the College representing such areas as Industry, Commerce, Law, Education, Medicine, Engineering etc.) and three nominees of Goa University.

He briefly introduced the newly nominated members on the Academic Council - The Governing Body nominees- Mr. Kishore Shah, Founder of 6m Solutions; Dr. Bhama Venkataramani, Dean, Academics & Administration, Symbiosis University, Pune; Dr. Ramesh Gidwani , Director, TEVA Pharmaceutical Pvt. Ltd.; Mr. Shirish Kotmire, Designated Partner, Seraphic Retail & Business Solutions. Vice Chancellor's nominees - Dr. Nandakumar Mekoth, Head Dept. of Commerce & Management, Goa University and Dr. B.F. Rodrigues, Dept. of Life Science, Goa University. Dr. (Ms) Pratima Kamat, Dept. of History, Goa University. Four teachers of the College representing different categories of teaching staff- Dr. G.K. Naik, Dept. of Chemistry; Dr. Debashish Majumdar, Dept. of Economics; Dr. Sanjay D. Gaikwad; Dept. of Geography; Ms. Meghana S. Devli, Dept. of Geology.

For the benefit of the new Council members, the Chairman made a small presentation of the College, its vision and mission statements, the infrastructure, and programmes run in the college.

The Member Secretary, Dr. E.M. Travassos gave a presentation on the background and adoption of CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) by the college under Autonomy.

The new members put forth their views and expressed their willingness to contribute to academic advancements by drawing on the expertise from their respective fields.

Dr. Bhama Venkataramani made a case for designing programmes that meet the vision statement of the college. She said that if we focus on Graduate attributes as listed in the presentation by Dr. Travassos, it would be phenomenal for our students. She said that during admissions, there should be counselling sessions to identify where the students belong and help them to choose the right courses. We should not only conduct the academic audit at the process level but also at the quality level. She also emphasized on faculty empowerment and peer review.

Dr. Ramesh Gidwani made a case for including the following as part of academics: Attitude & Discipline, Technical Competances, Focus on practical skills, Analytical skills to solve problems and improve employability, Strong Basics concepts and Collaboration with industry in designing the courses.

Mr. Kishore Shah said that research shows that 28,000 Graduates pass out every year in Goa, out of which 65% are female students. He also said that traditional jobs have vanished; and that most institutes teach students about everything except themselves. Focus should be on how to create opportunities here; assessment of potential is the key thing.

There is a huge requirement for individual assessment in the market but nobody is aware of it. He also emphasized on talent development & management. He said that he would work with the college for two man-days.

Mr. Shirish Kotmire referred to the trends in the environment today – Two Indias – the metro India and the rural "real" India. He said that the numbers of jobs are coming down. Education should have "ANJAAM".

India is going to be a country of consumers. It is a universal challenge to prepare students. Try and convert whole population of students from job seekers to job creators.

Dr. B.F. Rodrigues said that it is important to develop skills. Employability will follow. Skill based courses are need of the hour. Interdisciplinary approach is important. Peer learning can be positive and negative, hence there should be guided peer learning. In depth, teaching and learning is important. He also emphasized on ethics, respect for others, national interest, community living and environmental awareness.

Dr. Nandakumar Mekoth said that the college should invest in Quality teachers. (teacher learning is important). He said that peer group learning is important. He also emphasized on having a database for good research.
