Based on this analysis, the house felt that to improve the performance of the students under autonomy, it was suggested to block the admission to Semester V of students who have not successfully completed the previous semesters.

The house approved the above and amendment to ordinance AO. 1.3 to be made accordingly. The same is shown in Annexure X.

- ii. Mechanism for award of marks to students who participate in curriculum related activities, seminars/conferences.

Ordinance AO 4.16 to read as: 'Award of entitlement credit points for National/International level participation in N.C.C. /N.S.S. /Sports /Cultural events to be used under the choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for B.A./ B.Sc./B.Voc. Programmes'.

Resolution: Approved the above ordinance as shown in Annexure Y.
