The Chairperson welcomed the members of the Board of Studies (BOS). The Chairperson introduced and explained the agenda for the meeting and the Board transacted the following business:

Agenda Items:

- 1. To take a brief review of the syllabus of Semester I, Semester II and Semester III of the academic year 2015-16 and 2016-17.
- 2. To approve the syllabus of Semester IV for the academic year 2016-17 other than Core Elective ENG-IV.E-8 Representation of Gender & Sexuality in Literature and Interdisciplinary Paper Introduction to Mass Media.
- 3. Any Other Business (A.O.B.)

1. The syllabi and the titles of the undergraduate courses were presented and discussed at the meeting. After minor changes, the BOS resolved to pass the syllabi for the following undergraduate courses:

- 3. Resolved that the following changes to be made to History of English Literature from Fifth Century to the Eighteenth Century ENG-I.C-2- Semester I. It was resolved to reduce the number of lectures from 7 to 3 while teaching Anglo Saxon era.
- 4. Resolved to replace *The Great Indian* novel with Chetan Bhagat's *Five Point Someone* in **Understanding Fiction- ENG-II.C-3 Semester II**.
- 5. Resolved that the nomenclature of the paper Goan Literature ENG-III.E-1 Semester III to be changed to Goan Literature and Culture.
- 6. Resolved that the following changes be made to the paper New Literatures in English ENG-III.E-4 Semester III.

To delete the novel *Beloved* by Toni Morrison and to replace it with Derek Walcott's play *Pantomime*. It was also resolved to chose a few short stories and poets from the following:

It was resolved to include Bob Connel's Work on Masculinity in Representation of Gender & Sexuality in Literature- ENG-IV.E-8 Semester IV and to include two more references in secondary reading, namely 1) Eve Kosofsky Sedgwick, Epistemology of the Closet. University of California Press, 1990. 2) Ruth Vanita & Saleem Kidwai, Same Sex Love in India: Readings from Literature and History. Macmillan, 2000.
- 8. Resolved that the following changes be made in the paper Literary Criticism ENG-IV.C-6 Semester IV: a) To add the following in Course Objectives- To be able to apply literary theory to text, b) Unit I- What is literary Criticism? to be written as "Difference between Literary Theory and Literary Criticism", c) to delete Cleanth Brook's The Language of Paradox.
