This was suggested with a view to introduce a new approach towards teaching and learning the French language, to introduce the new changing trends in teaching methodology and to introduce the new French socio-cultural aspects.
- 3- To offer more choices of texts, for the course 'Study of selected elementary text in French', besides the text 'Candid', namely, 'L'avare' by Moliere, 'Gargantua' by Rabelais and 'Le Chateau de ma mère' by Marcel Pagnol. This was suggested in order to offer a wide choice of texts as to enable the students to select the texts as per their interest.
