The First paper discussed was Language in Context: Developing Reading and Writing Skills 2.1 Level 1 Part 1 Following suggestions were made to the syllabus: 50% of the Units contained in the Text to be used All exercises of Grammar and Vocabulary All cultural, lexical and grammatical learning activities related to the grammar, vocabulary and culture of these units Communicative and task based methods to be used to complete the teaching process Additional exercises based on written expression and comprehension. The BOS members suggested the following to be inculcated in this paper -Panorama 1, Alter Ego 1 to be added. Dr. Anuradha Wagle and Dr Edith Furtado also recommended the Methodes Echo and Version Originale. The BOS recommended French teaching manuals to be included in book references. The Second paper discussed was Language in Context: Developing Reading and Writing 2.2 Skills Level 1 Part 2 Dr Anuradha Wagle recommended Texts namely: A Propos and Alter Ego In addition to the above it was also decided to use Text namely: Panorama as the main text which consist of Text book, work book and CD. BOS members suggested books such as Champion, Campus and Taxi to be included.

# Following suggestions were made to the syllabus: > 50% of the Units contained in the Text to be used > All cultural, lexical and grammatical learning activities related to the grammar, vocabulary and culture of these units > Communicative and task based methods to be used to complete the teaching process. > Additional execises on written expression and comprehension based. > Activities to improve creative skills.

# 2.3 The third paper discussed was Language in Context: Developing Listening and Speaking Skills Level 1 Part 1

- Following suggestions were made to the syllabus.
- 50% of the units contained in the text used.
- BOS suggested additional exercises of oral expression based to be included.
- The Dr. Anuradha Vagle suggested exersices to improve oral skills to(elocution, declamation recitation, rolepay, presentations, debates, songs, Grammer exercises

## 2.4 The fourth paper discussed was Language in Context: Developing Listening and Speaking Skills Level 1 Part 2

- Dr Anuradha Wagle and Dr. Furtado suggested the following mediums in order to improve Spoken and Oral skills through audio and visual resourses: Role play, Recitation, presentation, reading, songs, videos, simulation, audio/video clips etc.
- Dr. Anuradha Vagle recommended cavilam, site and usauage of DVDs, Cds in French.
- Dr. Vagle suggested the inclusion of the following paper for the course: Introduction to Franchophone literature.

### 2.5 The fifth paper discussed French for Tourism and Hospitality Level 1 Part 1

- BOS members suggested a change in the Paper title: that is hospitality to be added to it, and to be renamed as Language paper in French (French for Tourism and Hospitality) (Level 1 Part 1)
- BOS members suggested a change in course objectives:
- This course aims at enabling the students to acquire basic skills required in the domain of tourism and hotel industry.

> This course aims at enabling the students in application of the skills in real life situation in the following areas: Part 1 - travel agents, money exchange, excusions Part 2 arrivals, departures, reservation, cuisine. BOS member suggested a pre requisite to this course that requirement of basic knowledge of French Dr. Anuradh Vagle and Dr. Edith Furtado suggested a book reference Fos Tourismo. The sixth paper discussed French for Tourism and Hospitality Level 1 Part 2 2.6 BOS members suggested a change in course objectives: > This course aims at enabling the students to acquire basic skills required in the domain of tourism and hotel industry. > Dr. Vagle suggested introduction of two entirely newpapers namely: Intiation to translation and Business Communication in French.
