## Proceedings

The Chairperson welcomed the members of the Board of Studies (BoS). The Chairperson introduced and explained the agenda for the meeting and Board transacted the following business:

### Agenda Items:

- 1. To approve the syllabi of Semester III for the academic year 2016-17.
- 2. The BoS has to appoint two members of BoS Committee for Academic Audit
- 3. A.O.B. Discussion and Resolution on the Question paper pattern of Semester End Examination.

#### PART A: Resolutions

- i. The syllabus of B.Sc. Geography was presented and discussed at the meeting. After following changes the BoS approved the syllabus of the course for Semester III.
  - a. The Board rephrased Course Objectives and Learning Outcomes of some papers
  - b. It was resolved that Elective Paper GEG-III.E-2: Raster and Vector Data Models in GIS should be a compulsory elective
  - c. Few repetitions were omitted from the syllabus, while, certain topics were added to the syllabus
  - d. The members pointed out few grammatical errors and spelling mistakes which were rectified
- ii. The Board appointed Dr. Pravina Kerkar and Mrs. Anagha Bicholcar for Academic Audit

iii. With regard to Question Paper Pattern of Semester End Examination, the Board resolved to approve the pattern, with following recommendations:

- a. The first question should be based on concepts/definitions. The question consists of total 9 marks
- b. Second question should be distinguish/differentiate between/compare and contrast/critically analyze. The question consists of total 12 marks
- c. Second question should be changed as Answer Any Three instead of Two and marks should be changed as 4x3 instead of 6x2.
- d. The third question consists of total 12 marks
- e. The fourth question should be essay type and application based. The question consists of total 12 marks
- f. Total marks assigned to the paper are 45
