AO-3.1 Course Structure of the B.A. and B.Sc. Programmes

AO-3.1.1 Explanation

(A) Core Courses are compulsory courses in a specific subject.

(B) Elective Courses are subject-specific electives and generic electives.

Subject-Specific Elective is an elective in specific subject offered by the student. Generic Elective is an elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject. P.S.: A course – a core or elective course - offered in a discipline/subject may be treated as a generic elective by a student of a different discipline/subject and vice versa.

(C) Foundation Course: Foundation courses are Ability and Skill Enhancement Courses.

Ability Enhancement Courses (Compulsory Foundation Courses consisting of 12 Credits) are courses in: (i) Language, (ii) Academic Writing, (iii) Research Writing, and (iv) Environmental Studies.

Skill Enhancement Courses (Elective Foundation Courses consisting of 8 Credits) are valuebased and/or skill based courses and are aimed at providing hands-on-training, competencies, skills, etc. These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill based knowledge.

Non-academic activities in a B.A. /B.Sc. programme comprise of two categories: Extracurricular Activities and Internship.
