REPORT OF BIRD WALK AT: MAINA-CURTORIM WETLAND COMPLEX

Guided bird tours were organized on 5th, 6th, and 7th February 2021. These tours were organized by the Goa Forest Department, Govt. of Goa as a part of the 4th Bird Festival of Goa. A total of 31 students/community participated in the bird walk, accompanied by Mr. Stephen Jonah Dias and Ms. Gautami Manakikar, faculty of Department of Zoology of Parvatibai Chowgule and forest official Mr. Guruprasad Viridkar.

REPORT OF BIRD WALK AT : CARAMBOLIM LAKE

Participated and guided Bird walk was conducted, on the occasion of the 4th Bird Festival of Goa, organized by the Goa Forest Department from the 05th - 07th February 2021 at Carambolim Goa. Local participants who visited the lake to participate in the birdwalk were accompanied by Ms. Prasanna Naik Gaonkar and Ms. Pratibha Tripathi, faculty of Department of Zoology of Parvatibai Chowgule College. They explained about birding and bird spotting during the walk along with Forest official, Mr. Suresh Narvekar.

Carambolim is one of the most famous and picturesque lakes in Goa. This lake has the added attraction of also being a great place for bird-watching. This manmade lake plays host to a number of species of birds, both resident and migratory. The lake and the forested area around it are so famous for its avian population that it has since been declared the Carambolim Bird Sanctuary. A total of <u>58 species</u> of birds were recorded in the area during the birdwalk.

Objective:	To provide students with skills and knowledge of statistical analysis commonly used in biological studies with the aid of statistical software.		
Summary of the proceedings			
	The programme had three principal units:		
	a. <u>Unit-1 Introduction to R and R Studio:</u> In this unit, students were introduced to the workings of R and R-Studio. Some concepts covered here include the differences between R and R studio, the R studio work environment, Packages in R, Vocabulary and Grammar in R, importing data into R and viewing data in R. In addition, various rudimentary mathematical and statistical calculations were explained using the software. This includes BODMAS in R, rounding numbers, relationship between R and excel; Objects, variables, and functions in R.		

- b. <u>Unit-2 Advanced statistics in Biological Sciences:</u> In this unit, the students learned how to perform complex statistical analysis using R-Studio. Major topics covered in this unit include generalized linear modelling, data normalization, ANOVA-analysis, construction of histograms and plots (scatter, sunflower, box plot), and multimodal hypothesis testing using Akaike's Information Criterion (AIC).
- c. <u>Unit-3 Project-based Activity:</u> Throughout the duration of the teaching-learning process, the students were given several analysis-based activities to enable them to practice the various theoretical concepts taught during the course. To help in better understanding of the concepts, several real-world examples were taken, and the students were subsequently asked to perform data analysis using the concepts they learned in theory. Furthermore, the students were asked to run data analysis on hypothetical datasets to understand how outputs could vary depending on the variations in the data.

As the programme was conducted online, periodic feedback interactions were conducted for the students to clear any difficulties they may have faced whilst performing the homework-based activities. To gauge the level of understanding, a summative open book examination was conducted at the end of the programme. In addition, the students were asked to submit a process-based portfolio containing all their work throughout the course so as to monitor their learning growth and development.


