


VIRTUAL INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES:

- The Centre for Exchange Programme conducted the first virtual Google meet between students from Bromma gymnasium, Sweden and Chowgule students on 17thFebruary, 2021 during this academic year. 6 students participated in the meet. The purpose of the meet was to provide students a platform to understand distance education and adapt to learning in COVID19.
