A on the 29 <sup>th</sup> July 2023 from 8:30 am to 4:30pm to the village of Barcem Canancona accompanied by Assistant Prof. Siana D'mello. The field trip was undertaken as a part of the course, Rural Sociology with the aim to learn about the rural social structure. The students travelled from Margao by a local bus to Canacona. They were guided by Miss Ashwini; a local resident of the village who took the students to the paddy fields where the students helped the farmers sow the crop. The students conducted field-based observation through interviews with the famers regarding the village structure, the social hierarchies present, the governing bodies, occupation etc. The students also helped the women to cook lunch for everyone. The field trip was quite successful and a fruitful experience. The students learnt a lot and gained insight about the lives of the locals.

Of Department of Zoology pertaining to Skill Enhancement Course “Waste Management Techniques”. Keeping in mind, how big of an issue waste management is 10 houses were visited and a small 5-minute interaction was conducted with all the residents. ### The Plight of the Girl Child in India: A Call to Action – Valois Fernandes

India, a nation of incredible diversity and rich cultural heritage, is often celebrated for its achievements in various fields. However, hidden beneath this facade of progress lies a harsh reality that demands our immediate attention and action - the plight of the girl child. Despite remarkable strides in economic growth and technological advancement, millions of girls in India continue to face discrimination, violence, and a lack of basic rights. This essay seeks to raise awareness about the challenges and hardships that girl children in India endure and emphasize the need for collective efforts to bring about change.

Gender discrimination begins early in India, even before a girl is born. The preference for male children is deeply ingrained in many parts of the country due to cultural and economic factors. Sex-selective abortions, female infanticide, and neglect of girls are still prevalent in several regions, leading to a skewed sex ratio. This gender imbalance has far-reaching consequences, including increased instances of child marriage and human trafficking, both of which pose grave threats to the well-being of girl children.

Child marriage remains a pervasive issue in India, especially in rural areas. Girls as young as 10

or 11 are forced into wedlock, often with much older men. This practice perpetuates a cycle of poverty, illiteracy, and maternal mortality, as child brides are denied the opportunity for education and proper healthcare. They are robbed of their childhood and the chance to pursue their dreams, trapped in a life of domestic servitude.

Education is a fundamental right, but it continues to be denied to many girl children in India. While the country has made progress in increasing overall school enrollment, the quality of education and the dropout rates for girls remain concerning. Discrimination, gender-based violence, and a lack of sanitary facilities in schools are significant barriers to girls' education. When girls are denied the opportunity to learn, it not only hinders their personal development but also has a detrimental impact on the nation's progress as a whole.

Violence against girls in India is alarmingly widespread. Cases of sexual harassment, molestation, and rape are reported daily, while countless incidents go unreported due to fear and societal stigma. The 2012 Nirbhaya case, which gained international attention, shed light on the brutal reality of gender-based violence in India. While legislative changes were made in the aftermath of the incident, the problem persists, highlighting the need for comprehensive social reform and greater awareness.

Child labor is another issue that disproportionately affects girl children. They are often forced into domestic work or agricultural labor at a young age, depriving them of a proper childhood and access to education. These girls are subjected to physical and emotional abuse, and their potential is wasted as they are denied opportunities for personal growth and development. Furthermore, the lack of access to healthcare and proper nutrition puts the health and well-being of girl children at risk. Malnutrition and anemia are prevalent among girls in India, leading to long-term health consequences. Additionally, girls often face inadequate healthcare, particularly in rural areas, where they may be married off at an early age and forced into early motherhood, risking their own health and that of their children.

In conclusion, the plight of the girl child in India is a pressing issue that demands our immediate attention. The discrimination, violence, and lack of opportunities that many girls face are not only a violation of their human rights but also a hindrance to the nation's progress. It is



imperative that we, as a society, take collective action to address these challenges. This includes raising awareness, advocating for policy changes, supporting organizations working towards the welfare of girl children, and fostering a culture of gender equality and empowerment. By doing so, we can pave the way for a brighter and more equitable future for India's girl children, where they can thrive and contribute to the nation's growth and development. It is time to stand up for the rights and well-being of every girl child in India, for they are the future of our nation.

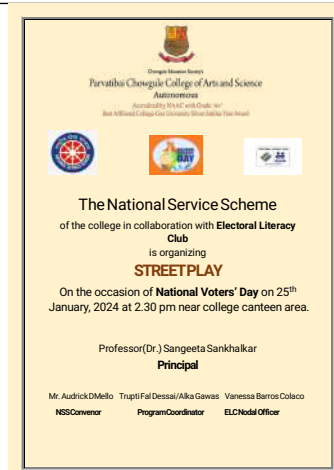

## महितांवरील वादता अत्याचार - एक सामाजिक समस्या

महितांवरील वादता अत्याचार हा एक सामाजिक समस्याचा मोठा विषय आहे. आजारी आणि अल्पशुद्धा यांच्यातील करारांमुळे महिलेला शिक्षा, आरोग्य आणि स्वतंत्रता यांची अधिकार मिळत नाहीत. जेणेकरून त्यांना समाजातील स्थानावर न्याय मिळण्याची संधी नाही. या समस्यांसाठी समाजातील जागरूकता, कायदेशीर सरक्षण आणि न्यायालयाची सक्रीयपणे वापर हे आवश्यक आहे. त्यासाठी सरकार, सामाजिक संस्था आणि लोकांच्या सामाजिक विचारांची बदलाची आवश्यकता आहे.

महितांवरील वादता अत्याचार हा एक गंभीर समस्या आहे. आजच्या काळात महिलेला समाजात समान अधिकार मिळवण्याची गरज आहे. पण अनेक ठिकाणी, महिलांचा वादता अत्याचार देखील चालू आहे. ह्या अत्याचारात महिलेला शारीरिक, मानसिक आणि आर्थिक त्रास होतो. महिलेला अपमानित करणे, वाचवणे, अशा प्रकारातील वादता अत्याचार अत्याचारांच्या आणि समाजाच्या घडामोडींना वादना आहे. या समस्यांसाठी समाजातील समाजातील शिक्षा, जागरूकता, आणि सरक्षण या तीन घट्टे आपापसावर अधिक लक्ष देण्याची गरज आहे. महिलेला आपले अधिकार स्वतंत्रपणे वापरण्याची समस्या देखण्यासाठी समाजाच्या सर्वांगीण विकासाला प्रोत्साहित करीताना सहाय्यी व्हावे लागते.

महितांवरील वादता हिंसाचार व त्यावरील उपाय...

महितांवरील हिंसाचार म्हणजे सामान्यतः कोणत्याही व्यक्तीवरील कोणत्याही जातीच्या आणि जातीच्या महिलेवरील अपराध, मुद्दे कोणत्याही प्रकारचे जन्म

शक्तीत, सहसा न्याय घेऊन, अत्याचार, विनयभंग, बलात्कार आणि बलात्कार आणि परगुनी हिंसाचार याचा समावेश असतो. दरवर्षी भारतात महिलेवरील अत्याचारांचे प्रमाण वाढतच आहे. 2012 मध्ये भारतीय महिलेवरील अत्याचारांचे प्रमाण 4 % होते. म्हणजे दरवर्षी तीन मिनिटांत एक महिला हिंसाचाराचा बळी पडते. भारतीय महिलेवरील मुद्दे अनेक रूप धारण करतात. सुद्धत या मुद्द्यांमुळे अजीवन, अपघात किंवा मृत्यू होऊन मृत्यू हे भारतीय महिलेवरील अत्याचारांचे एक उदाहरण आहे. जून भारतीय पराजनेमुळे वधूच्या कुटुंबांना लग्नाला बरीच रक्कम दिली जाते. हुडा ही संकल्पना आहे. गांधीय भवान वधू म्हणता. गांधी घाटी असते. हुडापेक्षाही वाढी जास्त लागणी पूर्ण करण्यास असमर्थ असताना ते वरातले माहितनेली रक्कम पूर्ण करण्यात आणि देण्यास अपयशस्वी ठरतात. अशा वेळी बलात्कार वधू वरच्या लोटी आणि शारीरिक अत्याचारांचा बळी पडतात. हुडासाठी तिच्या कुटुंबाच्या असमर्थतेमुळे महिलेला मारहाण केली जाते. शिवी दिली जाते आणि नियमितपणे विनयभंग केला जातो. हुडा मृत्यू बहुतेक वेळा भारताच्या ग्रामीण भागात पाहिला जातो आणि महिलेवरील अत्याचारांसाठी जबाबदार भाग बनते. बलात्कार आणि अस्पृष्टते लैंगिक क्रिया ही भारतीय महिलेवरील हिंसाचाराचा मोठा भाग आहे. आकडेवारीवरून असे दिसून आले आहे की भारतीय उपखंडात महिला सर्वाधिक दुर्मिळ आहेत. अतःपयंत बलात्काराच्या घटनांही संबंधित सर्वात धोकादायक देश आहे. बलात्कार म्हणजे सहसा तिच्या समतोलशिवाय महिलेवरील लैंगिक संबंध ठेवणे. ज्ञान आहे की बलात्काराच्या विषयाबद्दल महिला आता अधिक जागरूक आणि मुक्त झाल्या आहेत. ते त्यांच्या स्वतःच्या लैंगिक अत्याचारांच्या कथांबद्दल उपद्रव बोलत आहेत. तथापि भारतात सध्या वादता आहे. मुद्देगारना बलात्कारा शिक्षा भोगीवली जात आहे. वैवाहिक बलात्कार हे विवाहातील हिंसाचाराचे आणखी एक प्रमुख उदाहरण आहे. वैवाहिक

बलात्कार म्हणजे बहुतेक वेळा त्याच्या समतोलशिवाय आपल्या पत्नीवर लादून आणि त्यांच्यावर जबरदस्ती करतात. यामुळे महिलेच्या शरीरावर मोठ्या घमाणात गैरवर्तन आणि शारीरिक छेदछेद होते. महिलेची तस्करी आणि जबरदस्ती वैश्याव्यवसाय हे दोन प्रकारचे हिंसाचार आहेत. ज्यांचा भारतीय महिलेला बळी पडतो. भारतीय महिलेविरुद्ध केलेल्या हिंसाचाराच्या दुसरे प्रकार म्हणजे बलात्कार, परगुनी अत्याचार, लैंगिक तस्करी आणि अपहरण यांचा समावेश आहे. महिलेविरुद्ध केलेल्या पत्नीक दहा मुद्द्यांपैकी पुरुष तडूच वाचवून हे सिद्ध होते की महिलेवरील मुद्देगारीची उत्पत्ती भारतीय पुरुषांच्या मनात खोलवर रुजलेली पुरुषप्रधान विचारसरणीतून कशी निर्माण झाली आहे. पुरुषांपेक्षा पुरुष शारीरिकदृष्ट्या बळकट आहे. असा त्यांचा विश्वास त्यांच्या त्यांच्या महिला भागावर स्थित त्या शक्त पाळण्यास प्रवृत्त करतो आणि महिलेला समुद्रावाला वास जात आहे.

जो इवीचा अपमान करतो तो आडेचा अपमान करतो.

जो आडेचा अपमान करतो, देवाचा अपमान करतो

आणि जो देवाचा अपमान होतो

त्याचा विनाश निश्चित आहे

हिंसाचाराचे प्रकार...

महितांवरील हिंसाचार बलात्कार विस्तृत प्रकारांमध्ये बसू शकतात. यात व्यक्तींनी तसेच राज्यांनी केलेल्या हिंसाचाराचा समावेश आहे. व्यक्तींनी केलेल्या हिंसाचाराचे काही प्रकार आहेत. बलात्कार, परगुनी हिंसाचार, लैंगिक छेद, अश्लिष्ट फेकणे, पुनरुत्पादक बळजबरी, स्त्री-बालहत्या, जन्मपूर्वी लिंग निवड, प्रसूती हिंसा, ऑनलाइन लिंग-आधारित हिंसा आणि जन्मवटोळी हिंसा. तसेच हानिकारक घण किंवा पारंपारिक पद्धती जसे की हुडा हिंसा, अपहरण करून लग्न आणि

जबरदस्तीने लग्न करणे. अशा प्रकारच्या हिंसाचाराचे प्रकार आहेत. ज्यावर सरकारकडून अत्याचार होऊ शकतात किंवा त्यांच्यावर दंडात्मक कारवाई केली जाऊ शकते. जसे की सामूहिक बलात्कार, लैंगिक क्रिया आणि नसबंदी सक्तीचा शासनात, पत्नीस आणि अधिकृत कामगारकडून हिंसाचार टाळण्यास आणि मारहाण करी ही आहे. बहीण, पत्नीची श्रुतिका वार पाहत बौद्धिक जबाबदारी समर्थपणे पेलत असते. पुरुषप्रधान संस्कृतीत मित्रा पुरुषांवर अवलंबून असल्याने त्यांना स्वतःचा निर्णय घेण्याचा कायदा अधिकार नाही. त्यामुळे आजही त्यांचे स्थान जगभराचे असल्याने त्यांच्यावर अत्याचार अत्याचार होताना दिसतो. आधुनिक काळात त्यांना राजकीय प्रशासकीय व व्यवस्थापन क्षेत्रात पुरुषांच्या बरोबरीने संधी मिळाली पाहिजे. तरच त्यांचा आर्थिक दर्जा सुधारणे व राष्ट्राच्या प्रगतीत त्यांचे योगदान वाढवणे प्रत्येक सभ्यतेतील महिलेच्या समस्या वेगवेगळ्या आहेत. तरी सर्वसाधारण समस्यांचा विचार केला तर पुढील प्रमाणे समस्यांची वर्गीकरणे करता येईल. बौद्धिक हिंसाचार, सामाजिक हिंसाचार, शिक्षणाच्या समस्या, आरोग्याच्या समस्या इ.
