SWEDEN INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

The students, Eldon Gomes, Prachiti Vaidya, Sakshi Ahluwalia, Sreetam Halder, Jayashree Sanzgiri, Sanika Neurenkar & faculty member Ms. Madhavi. Motankar all from the Department of Biotechnology participated in the International Science Exchange Programme at Bromma and Tulinge gymnasium, Sweden for the year 2016-17. The exchange program took place during 22nd April to 07th May 2017. They carried out studies of Swedish society & nature. The exchange programme consisted of lectures, field studies, study visits with focus on sustainable development, equality & ecology. As a part of the academic research, they carried out several surveys & research projects on the traditional food preservation techniques and home remedy measures using typical Swedish medicinal plants used commonly in Swedish homes. Various other parameters of lake Bröjak, lake Aspen of Södermanland and Fjarlang were part of their study. Water bodies close to the mining areas were investigated at various points for parameters such as pH, temperature, turbidity, nitrates, phosphates, etc. Other studies such as those on Phytoplankton, microbes, probable threats to ecosystems & food chain were also concluded. A visit to the Greenhouse labs and Stockholm University was a part of their study for the program. The students took a lot of trouble to present the 'India Day Celebration' at Bromma gymnasium, Nyängsvägen, Sweden that was eagerly awaited of and most appreciated by all who witnessed the beautiful performances. Another highlight of International Exchanges is family stay. Students stay with the family of host students to experience the culture, social and day to day lifestyle of the family. It provides an enriching learning environment for students of both countries i.e. India and Sweden. Having enjoyed the programme, the students return to their home country with new found strength, confidence, and self-understanding. These experiences can help the young minds gain these qualities so early on in life — that is truly the magic of International Exchange programmes.



EERIE COLLEGE MYSTERIES UNSOLVED





As a part of the TGC programme, we got a chance to have an hour-long interaction with two American language teachers, who were here to get an understanding of our educational system and to give and take ideas for a better teaching learning environment, and a better world. Most of what they spoke reflected a drive to use their skill to help make the world a better place - using education to develop knowledge, tolerance and respect between communities cultures. Considering the current state we are in, one of fear and violence, of religious fanaticism, of intolerance and discrimination, of misdirected hatred and stereotyping - the work they are doing and the vision they have is extremely relevant. They are of a view that language, being the most generally pervasive of things that can be learnt and acquired, has the power to change minds - for it can broaden perspectives and open young hearts up to a whole different way of life. A new language brings with it the soul of its people, and teaches the learners of ideologies entirely different from their own, making them more open to accepting the validity of differing opinions and beliefs. Earlier this morning, I asked the programme coordinator what the most important thing she had learnt from all the places she had been visiting

was - and I loved her response - she told me, "I think the most important thing is that people, everywhere, are more similar than they are different. Everyone visits a new place and talks about how many things they do differently, but there are always so many things that they will connect over - humans are humans."



Is 75% Attendance Necessary

According to the policies of Parvaribai Chowgule College a student must have a minimum of 75% attendance to be eligible to answer their semester end exams. - **8)Rock Pigeon** it has a dark bluish grey head, neck, and chest with glossy yellowish, greenish and reddish purple iridescence along its neck and wing feathers. The iris is orange red or golden with a paler inner ring. The bill is grey-black with a conspicuous off white crest, and the feet are purplish red.
- **9)Wire Tail Swallow** a very distinctive swallow with two long, thin feathers, on its outer tail from which it gets its name. It has brilliant glossy blue upperparts and a chestnut forehead and crown that contrasts with clean white under parts.
- **10)Purple Heron** large heron with rusty head and streaky neck. Has purple brown plumage with slate grey wings, reddish brown breast, black belly and reddish-purple flanks and scapulars.
- **11)Green Bee** Eater- A small dainty bee eater that is intensely green overall with a greenish blue throat, a thin black throat band, and long central tail feathers. Flies gracefully as it catches insects and other prey.


