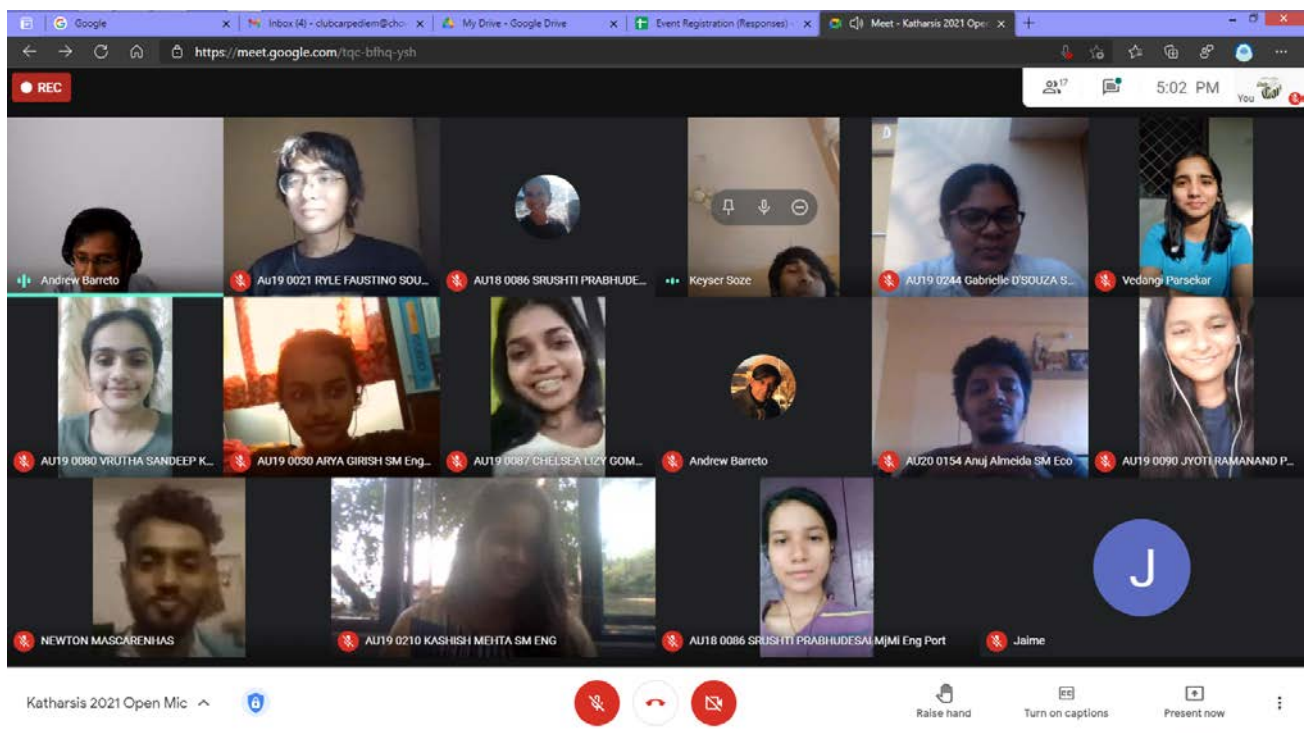

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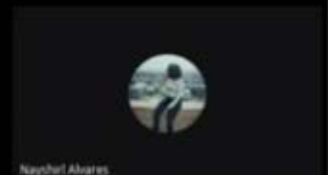

REPORT OF BIRD WALK AT: MAINA-CURTORIM WETLAND COMPLEX

Guided bird tours were organized on 5th, 6th, and 7th February 2021. These tours were organized by the Goa Forest Department, Govt. of Goa as a part of the 4th Bird Festival of Goa. A total of 31 students/community participated in the bird walk, accompanied by Mr. Stephen Jonah Dias and Ms. Gautami Manakikar, faculty of Department of Zoology of Parvatibai Chowgule and forest official Mr. Guruprasad Viridkar.

The participants were explained about the following aspects:

1. Resident and migratory bird species occurring in the man-made irrigation tank.
2. Resident and migratory bird species occurring in the agricultural areas surrounding the tank.
3. Standard avifaunal evaluation techniques: point counts and line transect.

Participated and guided Bird walk was conducted, on the occasion of the 4th Bird Festival of Goa, organized by the Goa Forest Department from the 05th - 07th February 2021 at Carambolim Goa. Local participants who visited the lake to participate in the birdwalk were accompanied by Ms. Prasanna Naik Gaonkar and Ms. Pratibha Tripathi, faculty of Department of Zoology of Parvatibai Chowgule College. They explained about birding and bird spotting during the walk along with Forest official, Mr. Suresh Narvekar.

Carambolim is one of the most famous and picturesque lakes in Goa. This lake has the added attraction of also being a great place for bird-watching. This manmade lake plays host to a number of species of birds, both resident and migratory. The lake and the forested area around it are so famous for its avian population that it has since been declared the Carambolim Bird Sanctuary. A total of 58 species of birds were recorded in the area during the birdwalk.

इनका जन्म १६ अगस्त १९०४ नागपंचमी के दिन इलाहाबाद के निकट निहालपुर नामक गांव में रामनाथसिंह के जमींदार परिवार में हुआ था। वे हिन्दी की सुप्रसिद्ध कवयित्री और लेखिका थीं। बाल्यकाल से ही वे कविताएँ रचने लगी थीं। पिता रामनाथ सिंह देखरेख में इनका प्रारम्भिक शिक्षण हुआ। मजदूरीवश वे केवल नौवीं कक्षा तक की पढ़ाई ही पूरी कर पाईं। १९१९ में खंडवा के ठाकुर लक्ष्मण सिंह के साथ विवाह के बाद वे जबलपुर आ गई थीं। १९२१ में गांधी जी के असहयोग आंदोलन में भाग लेने वाली वह प्रथम महिला थीं। वे दो बार जेल भी गई थीं। १५ फरवरी १९४८ को एक कार दुर्घटना में उनका आकस्मिक निधन हो गया था।

सुभद्रा कुमारी चौहान के जीवन की तरह ही उनका साहित्य भी सरल और स्पष्ट है। इनके काव्यों में पारिवारिक जीवन के मोहक चित्रा और वात्सल्य की अभिव्यक्ति है। इनकी रचनाओं में राष्ट्रीय आंदोलन, स्त्रियों की स्वाधीनता, जातियों का उत्थान आदि समाहित हैं। कुल मिलाकर सुभद्रा का राष्ट्रीय काव्य हिंदी में बेजोड़ स्थान रखता है। अपनी रचनाओं के जरिए उन्होंने एक बहन, एक माँ व एक पत्नी समेत सच्ची राष्ट्र भक्त के भाव व्यक्त किए हैं। पहले कहानी संग्रह की कहानियों की भाषा सरल बोलचाल की भाषा है। उनकी कहानियाँ नारी विमर्श, नारी प्रधान पारिवारिक सामाजिक समस्याएँ और राष्ट्रीय विषयों पर आधारित हैं। सुभद्रा कुमारी चौहान ने कुल ४६ कहानियाँ लिखी हैं।

जीवन परिचय

धूमिल आधुनिक विचारधारा के ओजस्वी एवं क्रांतिकारी कवि हैं। धूमिल का जन्म 9 नवंबर 1936 को वाराणसी के निकट खेवली गांव में हुआ। उनके पिता शिवनाथ पांडे एक मनीम थे एवं माता राजवंती देवी गृहणी थी। ग्यारह वर्ष की आयु में पिता का देहांत हो जाने के कारण उनका बचपन संघर्षमय रहा। बारह वर्ष की आयु में उनका विवाह मुरत देवी से हुआ। सन 1953 में मैट्रिक पास करने वाले वे पहले व्यक्ति बन गए। 1958 में आई.टी.आई. से विद्युत में डिप्लोमा करने के बाद वे विद्युत अंशुश्रमक के पद पर नियुक्त हो गए। सन 1975 में ब्रेन ट्यूमर के कारण उनकी मृत्यु हो गई।

साहित्य

धूमिल ने अपनी कविताओं के मध्यम से राजनीति के प्रति आम जनता को जागृत करने का कार्य किया है। आजादी के बाद नेताओं द्वारा जनता को दिखाए गए सपनों के टूटने का आक्रोश उनकी रचनाओं में झलकता है। उनकी कविताओं का एक मात्र लक्ष्य घर-राजनीतिक व्यवस्था को सही आईना दिखाने का रहा है। उनकी कविताएं अक्सर विद्रोही स्वभाव की होती थी इसलिए उन्हें एंटी यंग मैन कहा जाने लगा। उनके जीवन काल के दौरान केवल उनका काव्य 'संसद से सड़क तक' ही प्रकाशित हुआ और 'सुनना है मुझे' और 'प्रजातंत्र' उनके मरणोपरांत प्रकाशित हुए।

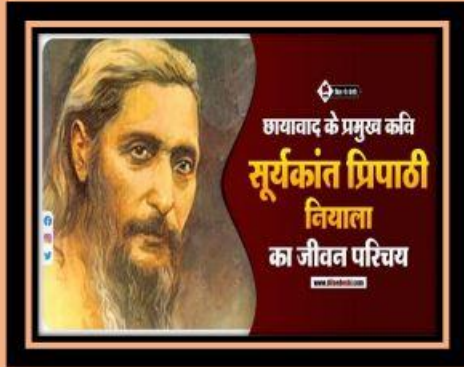

The speaker spoke to students about the Importance of Ozone layer and how human activities in the name of progress have been responsible in creating a hole in this protective shield.

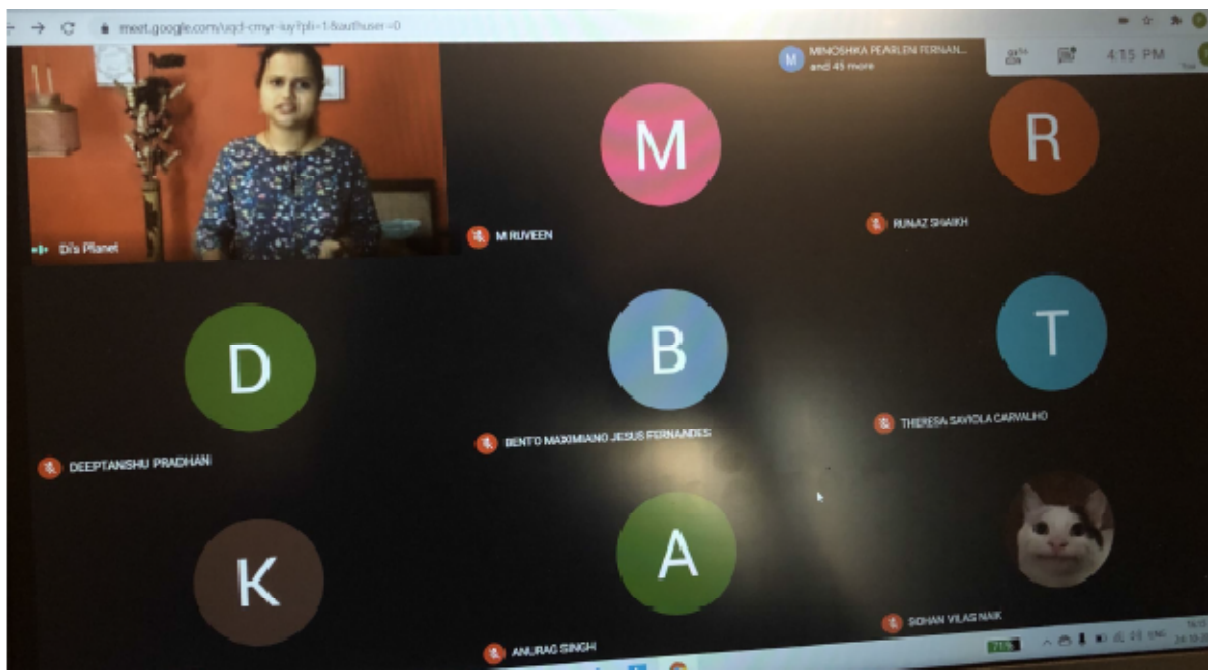
The speaker threw light about the current issues of landfills and global warming and urged students to take responsibility of their household waste.
