The objectives and description of the activity	The MoRD sponsored five days training programme on "Women's Health and Menstrual Hygiene" held from 11th to 15th October, 2022 organized by Goa Institute of Public Administration & Rural Development (GIPARD). Women go through a range of biological and psychosomatic changes in a lifetime. The programme focused on addressing Women's health issues and to empower women to take responsibility of their health.
	Day 01: 11/10/22 Ms. Arlette Mascarenhas, Course Director and Core Faculty-Women's Development, GIPARD gave a brief introduction on the training programme. The introduction was followed by a lecture on "General health issues affecting women" by Dr. Kunda Silimkhan, Practicing Physician and Yoga Therapist. The lecture

highlighted on the holistic health of Women: Physical, mental, emotional, social, and spiritual and that none of the areas can be neglected in order to live a healthy life. The afternoon half was dedicated to the topic "Sensible eating for working women" and "Local foods for better Nutrition". The talk highlighted the importance of nutrition in females as women play an important role in families and workplace and hence neglect themselves in this chaos. The resource person stressed that healthy eating boosts the energy levels and give one essential macromolecules, vitamins and minerals.

#### DAY 02: 12/10/22

The first talk planned for the day was on "Menstrual Hygiene and waste disposal management" by Ms. Ria Patil Chandray, Owner of M/s. Gia Industries, Manufactures of Organic Biodegradable Sanitary Pads. The resource person highlighted on the biodegradable pads they manufacture and the benefits of it to the females and the environment. The talk also illuminated the participants on the importance of menstrual hygiene in Women in order to prevent certain diseases and discomforts. The talk was followed by an interactive session

on "Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome and its affects in reproduction" by Dr. Jose Noronha, Faculty at SEA SCAN Academy and Kamaxidevi Homeopathic Medical College, Shiroda. The lecture emphasized on scientific background of PCOD, symptoms, risk factors and complications in Women. Much stress was given on our lifestyles in recent times as PCOD happens to be a lifestyle related disorder. The afternoon session was devoted to a very important topic considering women: Breast health and care. The resource person for the same was Mr. Reuben De Souza, Senior Surgeon at Sub-District Hospital, Ponda Goa. Dr. Reuben highlighted the participants on various issues pertaining breast and breast cancer. This topic was followed by briefing on topics like breast implants, abdominoplasty, gallstones, UTI and thyroid diseases.

#### DAY 03- 13/11/22

The third day of the training programme was a field visit day. The participants were taken to the Sakhi Industry at Piligao Bicholim Goa. Ms. Jayashree Powar explained and showed the process of preparing biodegradable pads. She also highlighted how this small business empowers Women to do better in life. Next field visit was to M/s. Gia Industries, Manufactures of Organic Biodegradable Sanitary Pads at Tivim, Bardez Goa. Ms. Gia gave an explanation cum demonstration on the procedure of making biodegradable pads, Josa. This industry had a more advanced set up as compared to the one at Bicholim.

#### DAY 04-14/11/22

The programme started with a talk on "Care during Pregnancy and during pre and post-

delivery. The resource person for the same was Dr. Jose Noronha. This talk was followed by a session on pre and post menstrual hygiene by Sr. Remy Lacerda, Ex. Faculty, Nursing Institute, Bambolim and Master trainer at GIPARD. The resource person explained the importance of menstrual hygiene with the experiences she came across with the children during her tenure. The evening half enlightened the participants on Awareness of STD, HIV, AIDS and Nutrition during pregnancy, lactation period and menopause. The resource person for the same were Sr. Remy Lacerda and Ms. Rohini Diniz respectively.

#### DAY 05- 15/11/22

The fifth day of the training gave an insight to
"Mental stress and Depression among Women,
After effects of Menopause or Hysterectomy,
How to handle pre-menstrual syndrome, Early
symptoms of cancer in women: ovarian,
endometrial and cervical cancer". Resource
person were Ms. Olga Netto (Psychologist and
Trainer) and Dr. Shekar Salkar, Senior
Consultant, Surgical Oncology, Manipal
Hospital, Donapaula. The five days training
programme ended with evaluation and
valediction by Ms. Arlette Mascarenhas. The
training programme was indeed a resourceful
one.

	topics. We started off with a session on
	understanding more about the concept of
	gender, its definition, and why gender
	sensitization is the need of the hour. We also
	had a session to discuss the position of women
	in society and how we can be more aware of
	issues that may arise as a result of gender

insensitivity. Post lunch, we had a session that apprised us of the various legal safeguards put in place for women in family and property laws. We were also provided with valuable information about how to go about with filing complaints and taking action against situations that may be motivated by gender insensitivity and misogyny. We were also made aware of the pertinent organisations working in the field of gender awareness, and where their respective locations in Goa are, as well as who to approach and contact when help in this regard is needed.

#### Day 2

The second day of the programme focussed on sessions that talked about the role of women at the grassroot level of local government, that is, the Panchayat. We were apprised of the different schemes for women at this level, as well as how women as local leaders in the panchayat were making inroads into predominantly male bastions of development, thereby epitomising empowerment and gender equality in local government. The session post lunch provided us with some useful tools on changing our attitudes and in turn our behaviour with regard to interacting with gender sensitivity. The focus was to use positive thinking and action in this regard and improve interpersonal relations at the individual and community level.

#### Day 3

The third and final day of the programme had sessions on eating and nutritional habits and

	challenges for women, as well as working men.
	We were able to have a better idea on various
	health issues and how important food and
	exercise are equally, and gender wise. We also
	had sessions on the United Nations' Sustainable
	Development Goal number 5, that is, gender
	equality, and how it was being implemented in

# Report on Faculty Enrichment Internship Program at IIT-Goa.

#### **Introduction:**

I completed faculty enrichment internship program at IIT-Goa campus from 9th January to 28th April 2023. The program was an incredible opportunity for me to gain practical experience, enhance my teaching skills and learn about the teaching practices followed in the institution. In this report, I will provide a summary of my internship experience, including my job responsibilities, the skills and knowledge I gained during the internship program.

### Job Responsibilities:

During my internship period, I was assigned as a Teaching Assistant for Computer Networks Course[CS212]. I also had the opportunity to observe classroom instruction and attend other courses such as Algorithm Design and Compiler Design. The tasks and responsibilities as a Teaching Assistant included grading for assignments, tests, quizzes and practical exams for the course and provide feedback to students. I was also given an opportunity to collaborate with other Research Scholars and Teaching Assistants which allowed me to gain a better understanding of teaching and evaluation practices followed in the institution. The detailed report of week wise activities is included in this report.

### **Skills and Knowledge Gained:**

Throughout my internship, I gained valuable skills and knowledge that I believe will be useful in my future career. Some of the skills and knowledge I gained include:

1. Improved Instructional skills and techniques by observing experienced teachers in my subject area and noting their instructional strategies and techniques by watching how they interact with students, design lesson plans, and provide feedback.

2. Use of technology tools to enhance teaching, such as online quizzes and interactive learning tools and Incorporating real-world examples and applications into lesson plans to help students understand how the material relates.

3. Encouraging students to discuss the material and work collaboratively in groups and providing students with timely and constructive feedback on their assignments and tests.

4. Attended training sessions, workshops and Presentations that exposed me to different research methods and designs used by scholars in the field.

5. Gained greater understanding of student diversity and learning styles.

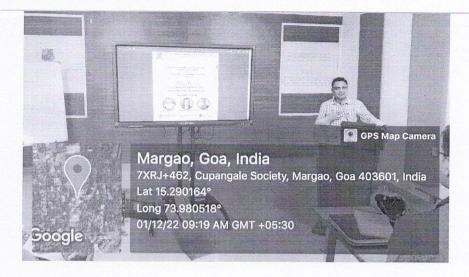
