Summary of the proceedings

Workshop on 'Research Based Pedagogical Tools': Regional workshop was organized at Parvatibai Chowgule College from 5th to 7th March, 2020. The workshop was co-organised with the MHRD-supported Centre of Excellence in Science and Mathematics Education (COESME) of Indian Institute of Science and Education Research (IISER) Pune and Parvatibai Chowgule College under DBT Star College Scheme.

The chief guest of the workshop was Prof. Venkatesh Kamat, Dean-Goa Business School of Goa University. The Resource persons were from COESME, IISER and conducted hands on training on research based pedagogical tool as effective teaching learning method, to 61 participants from various colleges in Goa, Maharashtra and Karnataka. The three day long programme trained teachers to develop Research based pedagogical tools (RBPTS) which can be used effectively in teaching- learning processes. It aimed at introducing research as a pedagogical tool to build an environment for the learner which promotes inquiry based learning. The Basic idea of this workshop was to train teachers to promote learners to think beyond the textbooks and do some research to understand the concept in more concrete way.





Resource Person: Ms. Madhu Balekai, Asst. Prof. Department of Zoology.



Resource Person: Ms. Amisha Shirodkar Pednekar, Asst. Prof. Department of Botany.


This Session was designed to help students understand the procedure and components of research reports. Details of preliminary pages and the sequence and rationale of the chapters of the main text was explained.



The Dean briefed the students of Hindi; Konkani and Marathi languages have been given the privilege to specialize in the language of their choice by this college whereas overall it is the English language being given importance. He further enlightened the students to develop skills in their own language of choice along with another language as well to prevail more power in the language/s. Summary of the proceedings	<p>Dr. Nandini Vaz Fernandes, Dean of life science conducted workshop for faculty members of Life sciences on “New Laboratory Journal record format” on 10th November 2018. The faculty members were explained the new format and pedagogy of conduct of practicals to make learning more effective. A sample journal in ‘Cell and Molecular Biology’ introduced in the Zoology department was shown as an example.</p> <p>The new format given has a Prelab work component and students analysis etc., and guidelines on how to record observations in a journal was given. Overall, the new journal format was intended to help students to use journal as a document for recording their learning in a more scientific manner. REPORT ON FACULTY ORIENTATION PROGRAMME ON “ENTREPRENEURSHIP”

Dean, Faculty of Science organized a half day Faculty Orientation Programme on “Entrepreneurship” on Thursday, 15th February 2018 from 09.00 a.m. to 02.00 p.m. in teaching learning centre. The resource person was Mr. B.S. Rivonkar, Ex-Director of Centre for Entrepreneurship Development of Karnataka (CEDOK) & IIT, Suratkal.

An brief introduction of the resource person was given by Ms. Shaila Ghanti in the start of the session. Thereafter Mr. B.S. Rivonkar started with an ice breaker session wherein five group were made each one had to tell something about oneself that would include SWOC and later on each group come forward and one group member introduces other group member.

There were some nice motivational real incidences were informed they are as following:

1. Shoe Laundry: Young person after college wanted to start his own business. Parents didn't support. After a while he was thrown out of house. He had only Rs. 7000/-. Rented a space of Rs. 2000/-. Few days just walked in one direction thinking. One day observed a pile of shoes outside the hospital. Approached the admin personnel that he has opened his own Shoe Laundry. Admin personnel agreed to given 100 pair of shoes to see his work. Next day it was delivered and checked of his services. He signed his first agreement. Thereafter hired one person to work under him and also went another hospital for similar services. Now he has his own business spread all over and even aboard.
2. Chapatti maker: The girl observed her mother taking effort to prepare chapattis every day. In her college project invents a chapatti maker. She patented her invention. Initially whatever no. of product was developed were sold in no time. Thereafter she came up with a company.
3. Pan Parag: A family man earned his leaving by selling his desi pan by travelling from one location to other. He usually had an half hour lunch break before a hotel and always observed that other panwala selling his product would be crowned with people. From there he came up with an idea of pan mix and he used to invent various favours and that's how he invented Pan Parag.
4. Mouth/tooth washer instrument in only 10 seconds to clean ones teeth.

Similarly many more examples were mentioned. He further informed that about communication is a very vital term and one needs to understand what is said / told and what is understood by the other person. An real example informed was on a well to do family daughter suffered from a rare disease were in she lost sight of one eye and if not removed immediately would lose her other eye sight too. A best doctor was hired from aboard to operate. The doctor operates and leaves back. On attending consciousness by the girl, she realises complete blindness as she is being operated with wrong eye sight. The fault took place by a nurse writing the report wherein instead of writing Left eye i.e. the Term 'L' it was written as 'R' i.e. right eye. There was a complete lack of communication and mistake as well.

A session on self rating was exercised by answering a questionnaire and scoring done through answering this questionnaire.

Another session was on idea generating conducted for all faculties where they were asked to generate any innovative ideas for starting their business.

Later on how the ideas could be generated was informed by analysising and observing the day to day activities.

Basic questions were inquired on the ideas mentioned that is can you make it?, can you sell it? is there a market for it? what costing is required etc.

Students need to know the following was informed i.e. technical feasibility, demand feasibility financial feasibility.

Faculties need to motivate, generate /take ideas, guide the students and if it works and is innovative patent it through CIBA.

He also mentioned that whatever mentioned is motivational but there are many difficulties faced as well, lot of homework to be done, self determination and commitment to do something is required.

Finally a vote of thanks was given by Aresh Naik.



