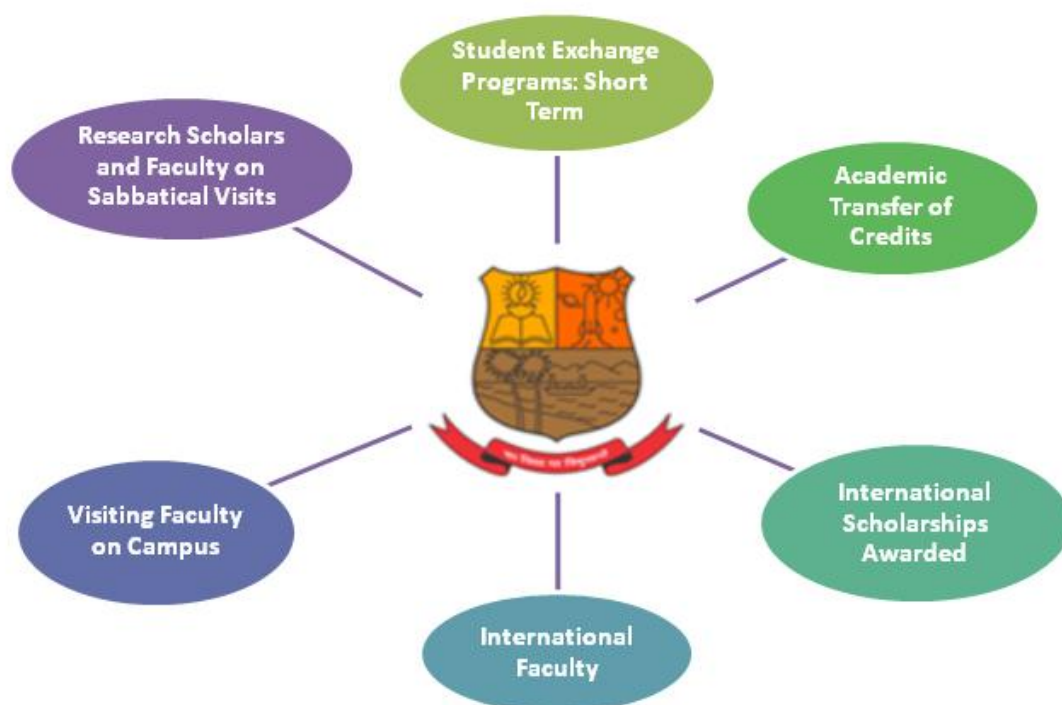

INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES

Parvatibai Chowgule College initiated International Exchange Programmes from June 2010. Through the exchange programmes the College has built strong connections with international institutions in Europe and Asia. The objective of the exchange programme is to enhance student's ability to assess and understand (in a relatively short time) the culture of new groups of people, and get global experience. The programme allows students the opportunity to interact with students and the local population of the host country in a variety of social, cultural and academic setting.

Waseda University, Japan, Tullinge Gymnasium and Bromma Gymnasium, Sweden visited the campus for a two week short programme this academic year. The programme is delivered in two parts: Educational and Cultural.

EXCHANGE WITH WASEDA UNIVERSITY JAPAN:

In Novemeber 2016, eight undergraduate students and two faculty members, Mr. Ashok Dange and Dr. Sameena Faleiro visited Waseda University, Japan as part of the cultural programme for two weeks. Students got to experience the foreign culture, interact with local students and people, attend guest lectures and understand how the educational system works in Japan. The programme also

provided students a platform to showcase their skills and talent through a stage performance called 'Indian Cultural Night' in Japan.

In February, 2017, six students from Waseda University Japan visited us. Keeping the objective of the programme the students were delivered a 2 week programme with a blend of culture, knowledge and social components. The programme was designed on similar lines as prepared for Sweden.

EXCHANGE WITH TULLINGE GYMNASIUM AND BROMMA GYMNASIUM, SWEDEN.

During the second half of November 2016, 18 students and six faculty members from Tullinge gymnasium and Bromma gymnasium, Sweden visited our College for about two weeks. The programme was designed keeping in mind students subject of study. The Natural Science students attended a guest lecture on ethnobotanical medicines and their use. The Natural Science and Social Science students attended a guest lecturte on Livelihood Strategies of Tribals in Goa which was accompanied by a visit to a tribal village, Cotigao. The healthcare students attended a lecture on education methodology used for special children followed by a site visit to special school (Ashadeep) in Vasco. Students

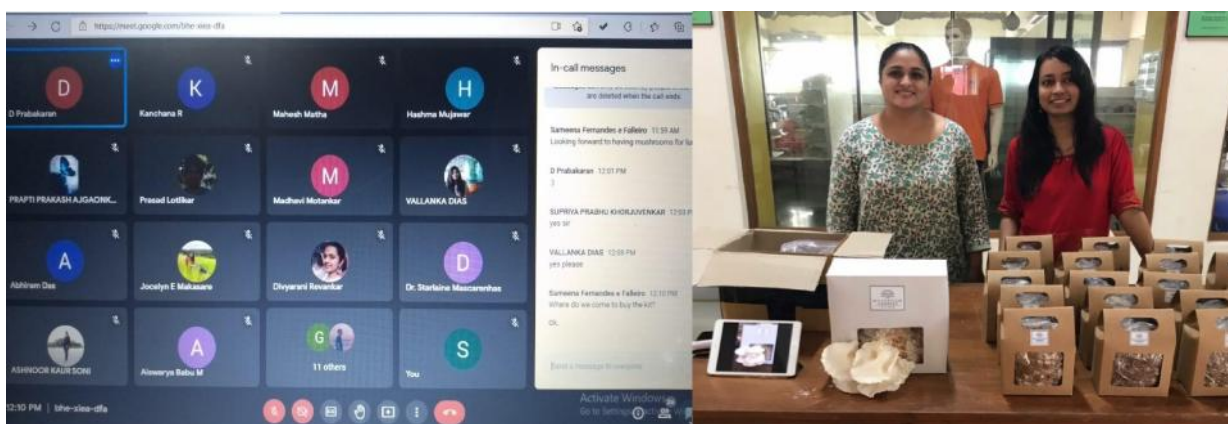

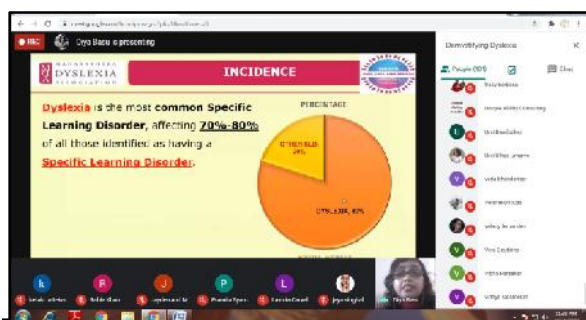
