Prevention of Discrimination Against Women And Elimination of Violence Against Women

Gender discrimination is the difference in treatment of a person based on sex that puts the individual at a disadvantage or limits his or her access to opportunities that are available to other members of society. Gender discrimination is a characteristic of most societies, with males on average better positioned in social, economic, and political hierarchies. For more than two decades, gender discrimination continues and still exists in society. The work done by women is not valued and does not get any recognition. It is considered that the main responsibility of women is to do household work and bring up the children. In most families, women do all work related to the home, such as cleaning, cooking, washing clothes, ironing, tailoring, looking after children, etc. Whereas, men go to the office and do outdoor work to earn their livelihood. Although women constitute half of humanity, their role in public life is minimal in most societies.

The primary cause of gender discrimination is illiteracy. People who are not educated continue to follow the old practices in the name of traditions and culture. They are not allowing women to go outside the home and become independent. This mindset of the people can be changed by educating them. Apart from educating the people, there is a need to educate girls and women to become aware of their rights. Girls are not given the opportunity to study. In India, there are few girls who go to schools, and among them, there are fewer who complete their secondary education. Only a few of them get the opportunity for higher education and graduation. Due to a lack of knowledge and education qualifications, girls and women could not find suitable jobs for themselves.

Because of this they have to be financially dependent on the male partner for money. They also don't have power and decision-making capability in their homes. Whatever is decided by the male members of the family, they have to follow that. Women who get the chance to work are underpaid, and they do not get a salary equal to their male counterparts. India is a male-dominated, patriarchal society. So, it becomes crucial that we make special laws and rules that favour women, so they get equal treatment in society. The Government of India introduced various programmes, policies and practices to ensure equal rights and opportunities for women in family, community, workplace and in governance. The Constitution of India also conveys a powerful mandate for equality and the right of women in its preambles, fundamental rights and duties. After so much effort by the government, gender discrimination still continues in many places. It is the responsibility of each citizen to stop gender discrimination wherever they notice it. We should save the girl child and celebrate its birth. Then only the practice of female foeticide will be completely banned in India. We must educate her and teach her to become independent. We should make the environment and surroundings safe for girls and women, whether it is a public place or a workplace. Now, women are seen in every field and sector. They are working as scientists, doctors, engineers, lawyers, managers, college and university teachers, and in various other professions which were earlier not considered suitable for women. So, it's our responsibility to boost their

confidence and help them utilise their full potential. We should provide special facilities such as maternity, child care and menstrual leave to make it easier for them to work.

Prevention is the only way to stop violence before it even occurs. It requires political commitment, implementing laws that promote gender equality, investing in women's organizations, and addressing the multiple forms of discrimination women face daily. The evidence about prevention has evolved considerably over the past decade, including as a result of various initiatives supported by UN Women. UN Women has played a key role in developing evidence-based policy and programming guidance on prevention of violence against women and girls. As part of its prevention strategy, UN Women focuses on early education, respectful relationships, and working with men and boys, especially through, and in, the media, sports industries, and the world of work. UN Women helps conduct research on attitudes, perceptions, and behaviours of men and boys, as well as young people, related to various forms of violence, and supports advocacy, awareness-raising, community mobilization, and educational programmes, as well as legal and policy reforms. In Asia and the Pacific, for example, UN Women works with other UN agencies on the Partners for Prevention programme that aims to reduce the prevalence of gender-based violence in the region through behaviour and attitudinal change among boys and men, as well as increased institutional capacity and policy enhancements. In partnership with the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts, and with inputs from young people, UN Women has also designed a curriculum-Voices Against Violence-for those aged 5-25 years. The curriculum includes tools to help young people understand the root causes of violence in their communities, and to help educate and involve their peers and communities in preventing violence against women and girls.





The objectives and description of the activity	On the occasion of International Women's Day on 8 th March 2023, Women'sWelfare Committee and SC/ST Student Welfare Committee organized an Awareness Talk on the Topic 'Safety of Women'. The main objective of the safety awareness talk was to inform and acquaint women regarding methods and programmes implemented to improve women's safety. Understanding approaches to stay protected from malicious and harmful elements of society was also an important objective. Ways to tackle the barriers encountered in women's wellbeing and comfort were also discussed. Creating a safe working/living environment through the police initiated Pink Force and imparting relevant information regarding the

same was reviewed by the Resource Persons.

Associate Professor (History) Sarita Naik Tari began the event through her Introductory Speech and welcomed the Pink Force withplants and flowers. Dr. Uma Masur (Botany),Convener of Women's Welfare & SC/ST Student Welfare Committee briefly introduced thekey note speakers Police Inspector Sudiksha Naik and Police Inspector Mira Dsilva. Officiating Principal Prof (Dr.) Sangeeta Sankhalkar welcomed the Pink Force Team in our college and addressed the gathering.

Thereafter, Police Inspector Sudiksha Naik spoke onthe different types of crimes faced by women including Eve Teasing, Sexual Harassment, Molestation, Rape, Trafficking, Cyber Crimes etc. She also instructed the students not to share their personal photographs with anyone and to inform their guardians when they step out of the house. She also informed the audience of the legal provisions and their appropriate use when necessary.

State Police Control Room and Pink Force Incharge Mira Dsilva showcased two videos of the Pink Force in action through which the audience could understand how the Pink Force actually worksa distress call is received from women. She also shared Emergency Helpline Numbers with the studentswhich they can use to contact the authorities when in trouble.She informed the audience that the Pink Force was started in December 2021.

As a whole, the talk was very effective and informative in communicating safety measures implemented for women. The compering of the programme was done by Assistant Professor Glynis Dias while the Vote of Thanks was given by Assistant Professor Alka Gawas (Hindi).
