- Clustering to be undertaken with the different disciplines i.e. commerce, law, engineering, management etc.
- Discussed the possibilities of restructuring the UG programme of 120 credits, to accommodate multidisciplinary courses.
- To adopt academic collaborations between institution through HEI clusters (for Commerce, Law, Engineering, Business Management, etc).
- To invite Principals from nearby HEIs and discuss about the possibility of forming cluster.
- NEP committee with HODs, to discuss the possibility of allotting the number of credits to Multidisciplinary courses

 - In stage I set up a workstation for start-ups i.e. a cubicle/sharing space with table, chair and high speed internet facility with computer.
