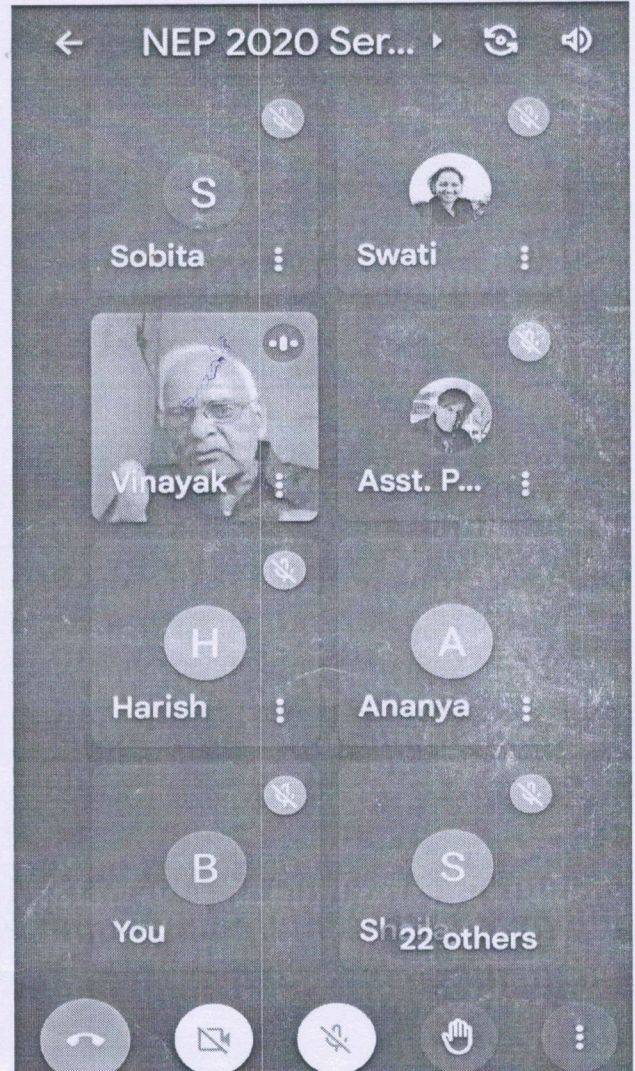
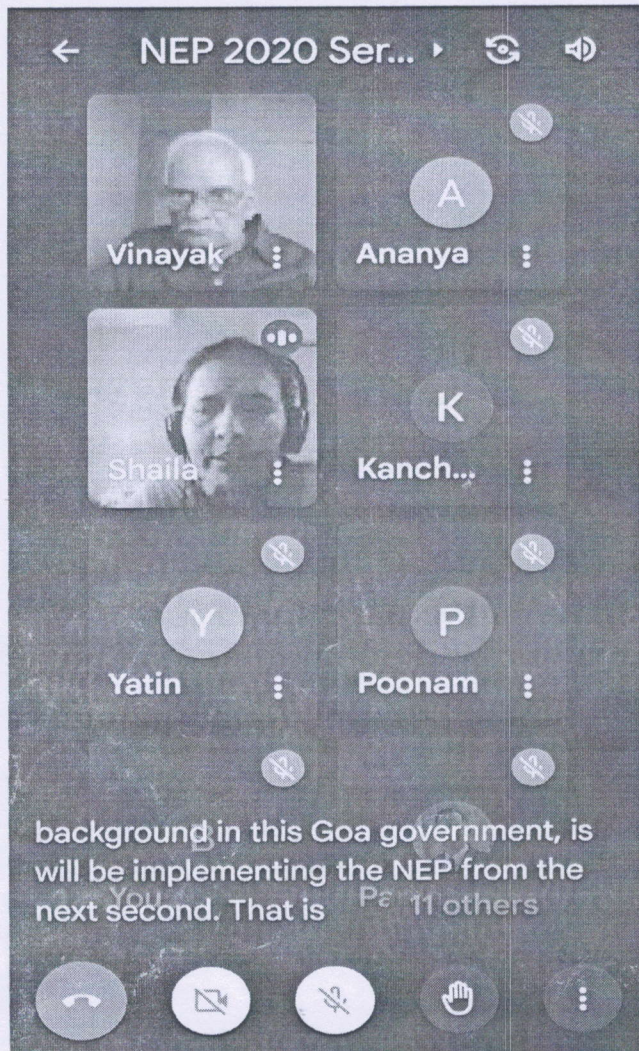

Liberal Arts Education which involves inter-disciplinary courses, intra-disciplinary courses, multi-disciplinary courses and trans-disciplinary courses.</li><li>2. Further going in depth he explained the micro concepts in these frameworks i.e. informed disciplinary courses, synthetic interdisciplinary courses and conceptual interdisciplinary courses.</li><li>3. In order to enhance/ develop the curriculum and the faculty steps have to be ensured i.e. train the faculty members in framing such syllabus.</li><li>4. How NEP is planning at University and College levels by creating categories of institutions i.e. a. Multi-disciplinary Research, b. Multi-disciplinary Teaching, c. Autonomous College, d. Higher Education policy of Clusters (i.e. 7-8 colleges come together to form a cluster which is headed by a Autonomous college like a mini University).</li><li>5. How our college can form its own cluster with consultation with DHE.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Being an Autonomous College the UGC might grant the leadership to our college.</li><li>- To become a mentor under the Paramash scheme i.e. mentoring the other college for NAAC accreditation.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Focus of NAAC will be in building the curriculum and faculty development.</li><li>- University has to incorporate the NEP 2020 in their statutes and ordinances thereafter only all college under its affiliation will be able to implement or do changes accordingly.</li><li>- Mentoring within the cluster or outside the cluster requires UGC's approval and there are certain grants also provided for the same.</li><li>- Mentor the colleges on the changing of NAAC process.</li></ul></li><li>- Institutional development plan -<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- <u>Tips</u>: a. systematic plan along with faculty members and management.</li><li>- b. Brainstorming (i.e. are we going for clusters / multidisciplinary courses? If yes for clusters. Is it within Goa/outside Goa.; what type of clusters are we looking at? etc.)</li></ul></li></ul></li></ol>



- Suggestions: a. To find out the relevance of the market demand in terms of placement to all students is relevant or myth. These findings could be useful to the government officials.
- b. While organizing workshops for FDP try involve representatives from government and industry to understand their requirements.

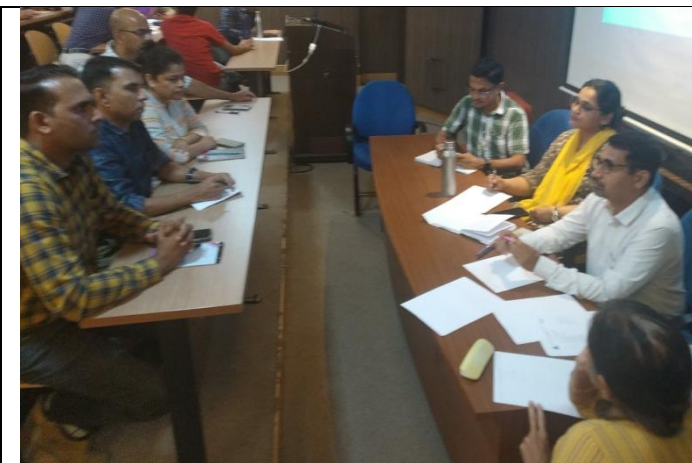

<b>Summary of the proceedings:</b>	<p>Teaching learning Educational technology Cell (TLETC) and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Parvatibai Chowgule College of Arts and Science (Autonomous) organized a 2 - day Faculty Development Program for all the new faculties of the institute. Eminent faculties in the field, Prof Dr. Nandakumar Sawant, Prof. Dr. Nandini Vaz Fernandes and Mr. Andrew Barretto were invited as resource persons for the workshop.</p> <p>The workshop was inaugurated by the convener of Teaching Learning Educational Technology Cell (TLETC) Dr. Sameena Falleiro. Vice Principal addressed the gathering and highlighted the importance of implementing different modes of teaching and evaluation for the benefits of the students.</p> <p>Two day workshop was divided in multiple sessions to facilitate better understanding of different modes of teaching and evaluation with hands on training. 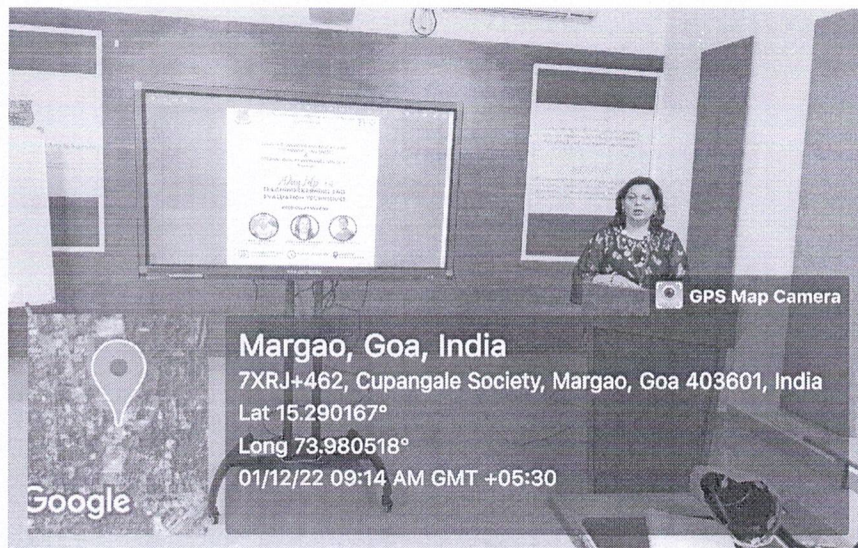


- TL Method 1 - Case Study

The workshop focused on familiarizing the participants with Blooms taxonomy and importance of implementing it to improve the quality of higher education in the country. Resource person explained the Blooms taxonomy and how different levels in blooms taxonomy cater to identifying different areas of students' knowledge. Session on Digital blooms familiarized the participants on different digital platforms that can be used to implement blooms taxonomy. The resource person familiarized the participants of different tools and web resources which can be utilized by the faculties.

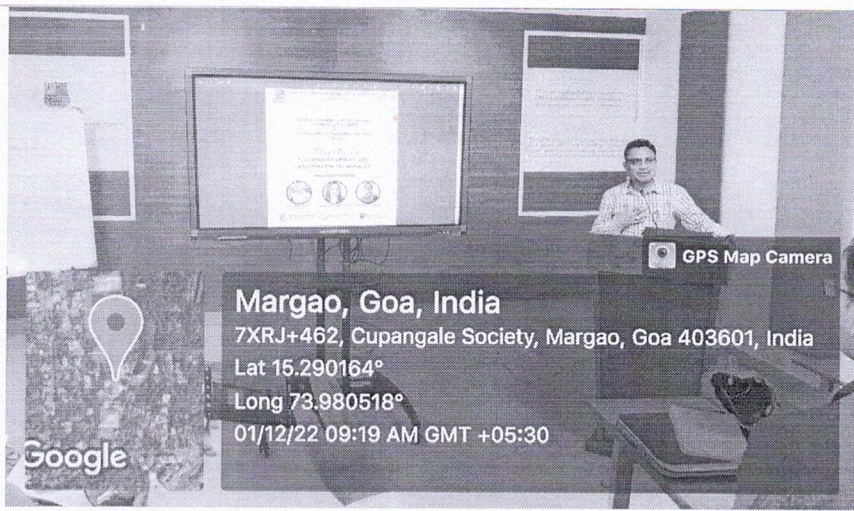

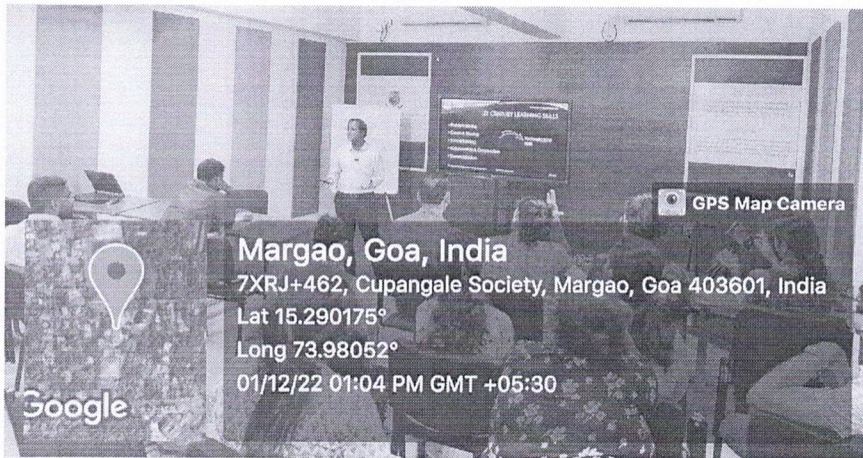

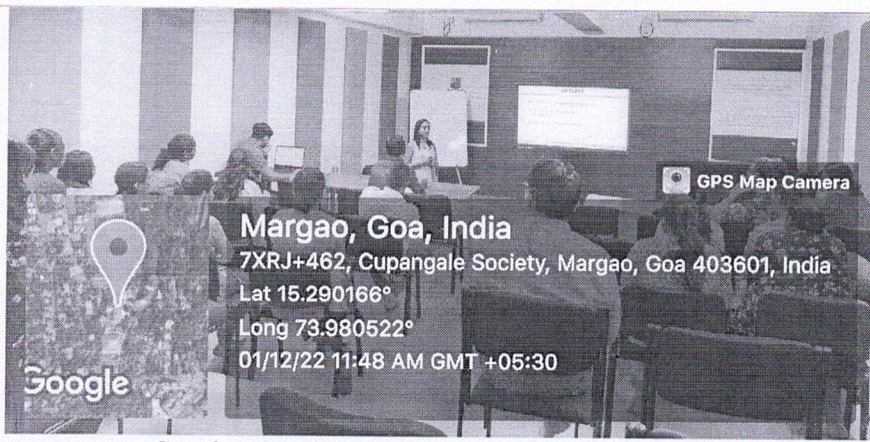

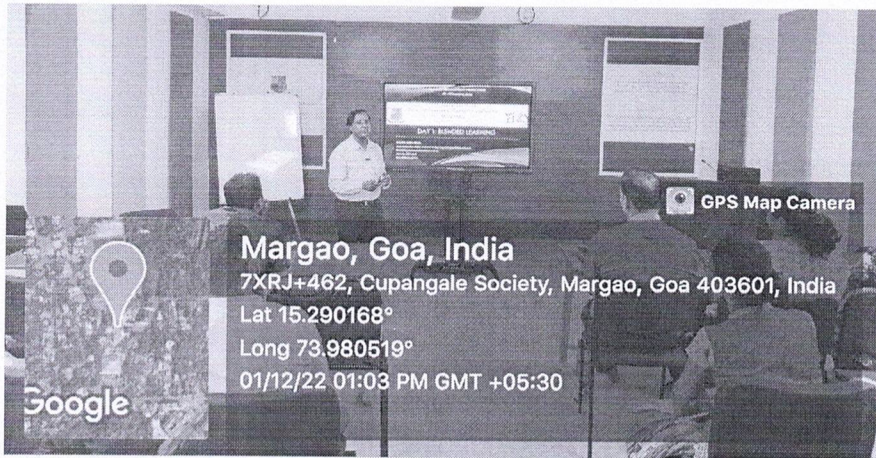

<b>Summary of the proceedings:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The TLETC and IQAC of Parvatibai Chowgule College organized 2 days' FDP on Teaching-Learning and evaluation techniques. On the second day the resource person Prof Dr. Nandini Vaz Fernandes held a session on overview of Evaluation method wherein she presented various modes of evaluation techniques and demonstrated how it can be contrast with digital Blooms'. She also stated all faculties can implement these techniques in their respective courses no matter what discipline it belongs to. She illustrated it with the example to understand the different modes of evaluation. She also conducted a session on Gobbet and Problem based learning, which are of the most important and interesting evaluation technique a faculty can implement in the course.</li><li>- The second session was conducted by Prof Dr. Nandkumar Sawant, he focused on the assignment writing as one of the evaluation technique.
