AGENDA: Plan and course of action for Community Outreach Cell 2022-2023

Discussion

- It was agreed upon by the members of the Cell that, to start with, we can go ahead with the adoption of 2 underprivileged Government Primary Schools/Anganwadis in the vicinity of our College. It was also suggested that if allowed, we can take up the same schools selected under IIC list. But finally it was unanimously decided to adopt the schools which are not developed. Schools already adopted under 'chalo school mega drive also could be adopted as the same are under privileged'.
- It was opined that if students could be considered for completing internship under these activities it would be an added advantage.
- Community outreach could aim at 1) Cleanliness / hygiene 2) Environment impacts 3) Academics 4) Skills 5) Training of school faculty 6) Psychological aspects
- Individual department expertise to be utilised under different aspects of this drive. Under the guidance of faculty, department students could be encouraged to be the resource persons for different activities.
- The cell should aim at "ACTION ORIENTED INTERVENTION" such that these underprivileged students get the maximum benefits.
- The different community outreach activities currently done by the faculty at individual level/department level may be brought under the broad umbrella of this cell. The cell may be informed by the individual/ department about their community outreach activity and later submit a report of the activity for documentation purpose. The cell may then list it under the relevant headings as discussed in point no. 3
- Administrative support and other support staff may also be added in the cell for efficient functioning.

AGENDA: Action plan of Community Outreach Cell 2022-2023

Discussion

- > The members had a quick deliberation on the plan of action and came to a following conclusion.
- Short term plan (2years): To identify at least 1 school in the close vicinity of our college and implement the plan as mentioned in the proposal on trails basis.
- Mid term Plan (5 years): Based upon the response of the above term, decision can be taken on the extension of the plan to community as a whole.
- Long term plan (10 years): The plan can be extended to more communities and adoption of economically backward schools can be thought off in case funds are received from the institution or Government.

Tentative plan of action proposal --- community outreach cell 2022-2023

The committee proposes to work on the following headers under Community Outreach Programme:

- > Educational/Cultural/Sports field
- ➤ Humanitarian Causes/Awareness programs
- Animal Welfare
- ➤ Environmental Advocacy

More headers could be added depending upon the requirement and larger vision. The Committee suggests that each department either individually or in collaboration with one more department may select any 2 headers to work upon and organize at least 2 activities annually. The departments would be free to work upon any other headers apart from those listed above. Record of such work to be maintained by the Community Outreach Cell.

Short term Plan (2 Years):

- Involving students by allocating them Internship and NEC hours to work on the field and identify the beneficiaries, identify the issue and develop strategy.
- > Remedial classes in the identified under privileged school (1 school only)
- > Rendering them Psychological assistance, if required.
- Guiding those students towards preparation of exam if required.
- > Visiting nearby societies to create awareness on social issues.
- Visiting Old age homes to inculcate love and respect in the young minds towards elderly people.

These are some of the activities which can be taken up by individual departments.

Mid term Plan (5 Years):

 Extension of Short term plan to more areas based upon the response of the above term

Long term Plan (10 Years):

Can think of adopting schools if funding is received from the Institute or Government.
