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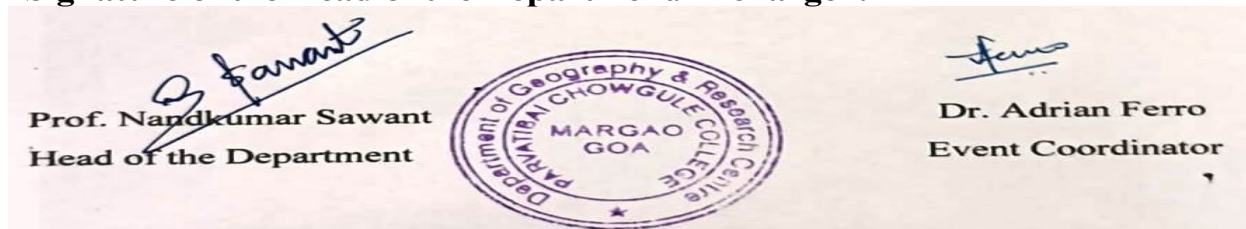

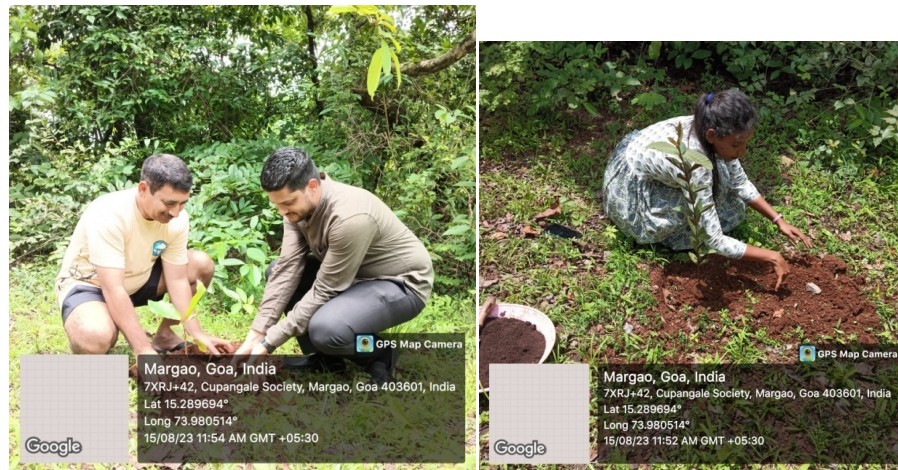

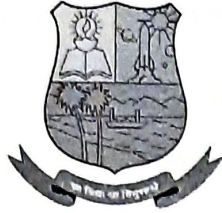

The camp was a huge success with a strong turnout. A total of 57 interested donors registered to donate blood. These included NSS volunteers, students, and members of the teaching and non-teaching staff. Of these 43 were found medically fit to donate, an overwhelming majority of whom were female donors.

The blood donation procedure was handled by the medical team from the Goa Medical College Blood Bank led by Dr. Sanjay Korgaonkar. The objectives and description of the activity*	<p>An awareness drive was conducted by the students. Of Department of Zoology pertaining to Skill Enhancement Course “Waste Management Techniques”. Keeping in mind, how big of an issue waste management is 10 houses were visited and a small 5-minute interaction was conducted with all the residents. Residents were asked about their knowledge on waste management and how they dispose and tackle with their garbage and were then given additional information and access to the playlist curated comprising creative wealth out of waste videos. There was no evidence of recycling but reusing of plastic waste was visible in their yard/houses. Interactions were conducted in 4 languages -Hindi, Konkani, English and Marathi. The younger residents were asked to scan the code and were instructed on how different methods of waste management can be conducted. The older residents were verbally explained and interrogated on how the environment has changed in a negative way over the years. All resident interactions were positive and created a sense of teamwork and confidence when it comes to performing in social spaces for the students. The interactions also helped us realize how much people need to be aware about what is going on in their state when it comes to waste disposal and environment conservation and how many of them have enough information.</p>
