COVID-19 has put our existing district/local-level healthcare system under unprecedented stress. Either the existing health facilities do not have enough health technicians, or there are plans to expend the health infrastructure in light of this pandemic. It is therefore, imperative that healthcare system be strengthened by creating a workforce of healthcare professionals in job roles relevant and related to services required for COVID-19. Towards this, following course of action is suggested.

Customized crash courses in six job roles under central component of PMKVY 3.8

- 2. Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is formulating customized National Occupational Standard (NOS) based 6 COVID-19 related job roles as suggested by Healthcare Sector Skill Council (HSOC) under central component of Pradhan Marth Kaushall Vikas Yojana 3.0 (PMKVY 3.0) for skilling upskilling with an objective to create large pool of trained skilled healthcare professionals. These job roles are:
 - a. Emergency Medical Technician-Basic
 - b. General Duty Assistant (GDA)
 - c. GDA Advanced (Critical Care)
 - d. Home Health Aide
 - e. Medical Equipment Technology Assistant
 - Philebolomisi
 (it may be noted that the job role of Medical Record Assistant has been included in the above-mentioned six job roles.)
- Training under these job roles would be a compressed one involving maximum on months
 of training followed by a period of on the job training, which can be taken up in PHCs: Govt.
 Hospitals in Districts/ Other hospitals, in which they will be working in the hospitals while
 finessing their skills.
- 4. Since there are reports of shortage of technical personnel in existing health facilities, and there are reports of expansion of such facilities in the districts, this is a great apportunity to creating local skilled personnel to service such facilities. It will be truthal, if you can identify the number of skilled personnel required to be trained, under various job roles. This dentification may be done by the District Administration, and for mobilization of candidates for being trained against this demand, help may be taken of the District Skill Committee (DSC).
- Hence, District Collectors may be requested to urgarity share the job-tole was number
 of candidates they will like to be trained in the above-mentioned job roles for initiating the
 programme latest by 01" June, 2021. The job-role wise number of cardidates may be uploaded
 in the Skill India Portal [SIP]directly at https://skillindia.redomda.org. The DSCs may also start
 mobilizing candidates at the ratio of 1:1.5 for being trained.

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To identify the number of persons required to be trained in the above job roles by sharing directly through the SIP latest by 01° June, 2021
 Ask the District Administration/ District Skill Committees to mobilize candidates for being

trained under the above job roles.
