The internship took place in Coimbatore at Aximsoft, which is one of Infiswifts leading partners.

The students helped the company in developing various software modules ,logos , email templates and also worked closely with the companies RND team. Castor, Swapnil and Wendham worked for C Programming team they wrote various C libraries, a Jason Parser and also documented the MQTT mosquito broker Tushar who is Chowgule FOSS clubs lead designer worked with the User Interface team where he helped them with ideas for a new logo and worked on email templates . The resource person for the seminar was Mr. Sarva Thulasingam, Chief Technical Officer. Infiswift Inc., California, USA. Mr. Kumaresh V.C., Associate Professor of the department was the coordinator for the seminar, he introduced the resource person. Around 20 participants from other colleges attended along with the students and faculties of our college. The Head of the Department, Mr. D. Prabakaran welcomed the gathering. The seminar was very informative and stressed on a companies perspective of developing software product.

Under the topic on Information Infrastructure he explained about how the raw data is transformed to information then to knowledge which will be useful to take action. He discussed about immediate business value and Return on Investment (Rol), how to enhance customer/partner experience, increase efficiency and reduce costs under Business Goals. He also stressed on the software team being small. smart and work together to deliver the Minimum Viable Product (MVP) faster and then add features as we go. He explained the various stages like Idea, Design, Coding and Documentation under Process. Finally he elaborated the Software Design principles on both Server and Client side. At the end the question-answer session was very

interactive. We are looking forward to organize similar events in future.
