Admissions

The Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications (PGDCA), and The Masters of Science in Information Technology (MSc IT) are the two post graduate programs being offered by the department. The Department also offers undergraduate BSc Computer Science Program.

MSc (Information Technology)

35 Applications were received for the admission of MSc (IT). As part of the admission procedure into MSc (IT), an entrance test was conducted in June for the interested applicants. A group of the highest scoring applicants was selected. 20 Students were admitted for MSc (IT)Part-I and 17 Students were admitted for MSc (IT)-Part-II. Maximum intake is 20.

PGDCA

This year we got tremendous response

for PGDCA course. 53 candidates have applied online for PGDCA course. Counselling was held to determine the best among this group based on their pure passion and inner drive to learn and Excel in the field of IT. Number of candidates admitted to the course is 30. Maximum intake is 30. Admissions closed.

BSc (Computer Science)

20 students were admitted for FYBSc. These newly selected Tigers then Completed their admission process by the mid of June and were welcomed into the Chowgule Tigers Den. With that very elaborate selection process, the new Tigers are now being trained to excel in their field and take on any challenges that come their way. Maximum intake capacity is 20. There are 17 students in SYBSc and 9 in TYBSc.
