The Governing Body meeting started at 10:00 am.

Dr. Ananya Das, Member Secretary of the Governing Body welcomed the members of Governing Body and sought permission from the Chairman to allow her to proceed with the meeting.

The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Governing Body, and wished a Happy New Year to the members and their families. She congratulated the Member Secretary for the wonderful work done by her, and the College Team, and permitted the Member Secretary to proceed with the Meeting.

1. To approve:

a. Minutes of the 17th meeting of the Governing Body held on 13th July 2022

The Member Secretary briefed the members that minutes of the 17th meeting of the Governing Body were circulated on 20th July 2022, and informed that no inputs or suggestions were received from the members. The Member Secretary sought approval of the minutes, and the same was approved.

b. Proposed Syllabi of various courses of the Undergraduate and Postgraduate Degree Programmes, as approved by Academic Council meeting held on 10th December 2022

Members sought to know if the proposed syllabi are as per NEP 2020.

Dr. Sachin Moraes explained that the proposed syllabi are revised and a few new courses taken up and approved by Academic Council, and are meant to be offered to the students under the existing course structure of UG programme. He also informed the members that the College Team is working on the UG programme structure based on the guidelines recommended by UGC in context of implementation of NEP 2020.

Shri. Kumresh V.C. brought to the notice of members that the new UG and PG programme structures will be implemented from the next academic year 2023-2024, in phase wise manner,

whereas the proposed syllabi will be offered to the T.Y. and S.Y. students for the next academic year 2023-24 under existing UG programme structure.

Resolution: The house approved the proposed Syllabi of various courses of the Undergraduate and Postgraduate Degree Programmes, as approved by Academic Council with the following suggestions:

- i) To revisit the syllabi to remove typographical errors.
- ii) To use standard format for the course structure for all the subjects.

c. Amendment to Postgraduate Degree Ordinance AO-5A

Dr. G. K. Naik briefed about the amendments brought into the PG programmes under the Choice Based Credit System (in the subjects of Language, Social Science and Science) to be offered to students of our college from the next academic year 2023-2024. He explained the members that at present PG programmes offered are of 64 credits, and which is now made to 80 credits based on the guidelines recommended by UGC in context of implementation of NEP 2020.

Resolution: The house approved the amendment to Postgraduate Degree Ordinance AO-5A.

d. Revised grading table (SGPA and CGPA) for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Degree/Diploma Programmes

Resolution: The house approved the revised grading table (SGPA and CGPA) for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Degree / Diploma Programme with the following suggestion:

- i) CGPA to Percentage conversion has to be included in the marksheet.
- e. Format of provisional passing certificate to be issued to B.Voc. students for Certificate/ Diploma/ Advanced Diploma B.Voc. Programme

Resolution: The house approved the format of provisional passing certificate to be issued to B. Voc. Students for Certificate/Diploma/Advance Diploma B.Voc. Programme with the following suggestion:

- i) NAAC accreditation A+ of the college has to be included on the provisional passing certificates.
- f. Budget of Autonomy Grant for the financial year 2023-24 as per UGC pattern of assistance for Autonomous Colleges, approved by Finance Committee

Shri. Alberto Barreto briefed that few changes in-line with NEP 2020 implementation in the next academic year 2023-24 are incorporated in the Finance Budget.

4. To report the status of implementation of NEP 2020

Member Secretary informed that the college will be signing the MoU with 13 other Higher Education Institutions in the State of Goa that forms part of the APARANT Cluster HEI, to address the multidisciplinary nature of UG programmes, as per the guidelines to implement NEP 2020.

Resolution: The house gave the following suggestion:

i) The revised UG Course structure as per the guidelines of NEP 2020 has to be presented in the forthcoming Governing Body Meeting.

5. Any Other Business (A.O.B.)

The Member Secretary brought to the notice of the members that UGC vide its letter No, F. 22-1/2017 (AC) dated 7th December 2021 (a copy marked to the College) had intimated to the Goa University regarding extension of Autonomy Status to the college for the period 2021-2022 to 2025-2026 including ex post facto approval for the period 2020-2021.

While no formal notification/order regarding the extension of Autonomous Status has been received from the Goa University, however it is presumed to be confirmed and extended in accordance with the provision of paragraph 3 and 6 of UGC Guideline in Autonomy 2018 stiputating a 30 days period.

Resolution: The house suggested the following:

- i) Letters may be sent to Goa University and DHE.
- ii) Review Committee to be constituted and report to be uploaded on the College website.

The meeting ended at 11:55am, with a vote of thanks proposed by the Chairman, followed by a congratulatory note to Cdr. Parijat Sinha (Retd.), Dr. Ananya Das and the College Team for their contributions. Dr. Ramesh V. Gaonkar also congratulated the Management, Officiating Principal, Staff and the students for their achievements.

Dr. Ramesh V. Gaonkar brought to the notice of the house, the vision of Shri.
