The Member Secretary read out the minutes of the previous Academic Council meeting held on 25th January, 2022 and the following clarifications with respect to resolution passed in Agenda No. 3 of the previous meeting was placed.

- a) Resolution to keep the **Amended B.Voc. Ordinance AO-6** in abeyance for the academic year 2021-22, and to be implemented from the next academic year 2022-2023 onwards for the new batches.

Dr. Sameena Falleiro, Chairperson, Board of Studies, Computer Science informed the house that the syllabi of skilled component courses has been procured from NASSCOM as per the National Occupational Standards for job roles of Junior Software Development and Web Developer, which will be adopted and implemented from the academic year 2022-2023.

Dr. Meghana Devli, Dean of Science, presented the revised course structure to be introduced at the undergraduate level (B.A. and B.Sc.) phase-wise from the academic year 2022-2023. 3. **To approve the proposed Syllabi of various courses of the Undergraduate and Postgraduate Degree Programmes, as recommended by the respective Board of Studies.**

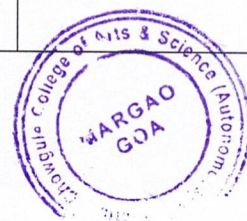

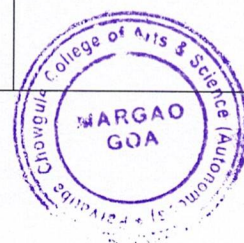

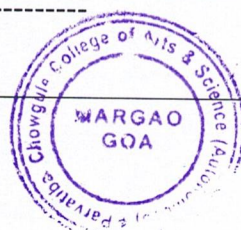

New Addition in Postgraduate Degree Ordinance AO-5A.5: The College will conduct a **Special Examination** to provide an opportunity to any student who has completed the fourth semester but has failed to get at least the minimum P grade for passing, in any of the courses of Semester IV for which they have kept term during Semester IV. To improve the grade in that course, this special examination will be conducted after the declaration of results of the regular examinations held at the end of the fourth semester.

New Addition in Postgraduate Diploma Ordinance AO-9.5: The College will conduct a Special Examination to provide an opportunity to any student who has completed the second semester but has failed to get at least the minimum P grade for passing, in any of the courses of Semester II for which they have kept term during Semester II. To improve the grade in that course, this special examination will be conducted after the declaration of results of the regular examinations held at the end of the second semester.

Resolution : Approved. To be implemented for the students registered from the academic year 2022-23.

Suggestions : The course teacher will submit the list of eligible students to the examination cell, depending on the criteria specified in Annexure X.
