New Addition in Postgraduate Degree Ordinance AO-5A.5: The College will conduct a Special Examination to provide an opportunity to any student who has completed the fourth semester but has failed to get at least the minimum P grade for passing, in any of the courses of Semester IV for which they have kept term during Semester IV. To improve the grade in that course, this special examination will be conducted after the declaration of results of the regular examinations held at the end of the fourth semester.

New Addition in Postgraduate Diploma Ordinance AO-9.5: The College will conduct a Special Examination to provide an opportunity to any student who has completed the second semester but has failed to get at least the minimum P grade for passing, in any of the courses of Semester II for which they have kept term during Semester II. To improve the grade in that course, this special examination will be conducted after the declaration of results of the regular examinations held at the end of the second semester.

Resolution : Approved. To be implemented for the students registered from the academic year 2022-23.

Suggestions : The course teacher will submit the list of eligible students to the examination cell, depending on the criteria specified in Annexure X.
