# 3. To approve the course structure and syllabus of Semester I and II of two new programmes:

- i) B.Sc. Environment Science and Impact Assessment.

# 4. To approve the pattern of question papers for OBE implementation.

National Education Policy emphasizes on Outcome Based Education as a fundamental component of our education system and there is a focus to move from rote memorization to learning centric approach. The NAAC criteria 2.6 also emphasizes on OBE implementation. Hence there is a strong need to streamline all programmes and courses that are run by the college. Based on this, the guidelines to paper setters with respect to Assessments/Evaluations over a Semester and the proposed question paper were presented.



**Resolution** : Approved with the following suggestions:

- i) The question paper should be framed in a manner that would enable an average student to achieve the minimum score required to earn the credits.
- ii) Ordinance to be framed for the same.
- 5. To approve maximum of 20% of total programme credits obtained from ODL/ any other online courses approved by the college.

In view of implementation of NEP 2020, students have been given an option of pursuing online courses under ODL or any other platform approved by the college.

**Resolution** : Approved maximum of 20% of total programme credits with the following suggestions:

- i) Students should offer these courses in the second or third semester.
- ii) The respective Department Faculty Council (DFC) should shortlist and approve the courses to be pursued by students online.

## 6. Any Other Business (A.O.B.)

- i) Consideration of NCC/NSS/Sports entitlement marks:
  - Under the Autonomous structure, the college had implemented mandatory nonevaluative credits and entitlement marks for NCC/NSS/ Sports were withdrawn. However, with the implementation of NEP, the non-evaluative credits are optional and hence the college has decided to consider the NCC/NSS/Sports entitlement marks. Accordingly, Ordinance AO-20.8 relating to entitlement marks at the Semester End Examinations was presented.

Resolution : Ordinance AO-20.8 is approved.

ii) One-time Special Examination for the students in view of covid pandemic:

In view of covid pandemic, the students who were admitted during the academic year 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018 and having backlogs will be granted a one time special examination to complete the Programme, beyond double the duration, subject to certain conditions as mentioned in the college Special Ordinance SO-1.

Resolution : The house approved the one-time special examination to students.
