Chairman's Welcome

The Chairperson, Prof. (Dr.) Sangeeta G. Sankhalkar, warmly welcomed all members of the Academic Council and emphasized that the purpose of the offline meeting was to foster meaningful discussions. She also informed the house that the Controller of Examination and the PG Coordinators of each PG program has been invited as Special Invitees to present their respective agendas.

Subsequently, the Agenda for the meeting was taken up by the Member Secretary.

Minutes of 22nd Academic Council Meeting dated 29-10-2024



1. To approve the minutes of the meeting of the Academic Council held on 14th March 2024.

The Member Secretary updated the Academic Council on the implementation of suggestions made by the Academic Council in the previous meeting:

- i) The phrase "POs will be implemented with respect to the relevance of the course" has been added to the description of every Programme Outcome of the college.
- ii) Heads of Departments have been notified that each course should include activities that reflect the Programme Outcomes, in line with the Academic Council's recommendations.
- iii) Suggestions made with respect to syllabi have been incorporated by the respective BOS and the same will be presented in this meeting for approval.
- iv) In response to the recommendation that Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs) should be measurable, the Member Secretary informed that the college has initiated attainment calculations. The Outcome-Based Education (OBE) team is currently training faculty on the attainment process, and the college has developed software to facilitate direct input of marks, enabling effective mapping of Course Learning Outcomes (CLOs) with Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs) and Programme Outcomes (POs).
- v) As per the suggestions of the Governing Body, a special internal committee was formed for vetting of the MDC and VAC Courses, its contents and relevance, before they were presented in the respective Board of Studies for final approval.
- vi) Regarding the revision of assessments in alignment with Outcome-Based Education (OBE) under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the Member Secretary informed that the OBE team, in collaboration with the Examination department, has developed a new question paper format. This proposal ensures that all Course Learning Outcomes (CLOs) receive proportional weightage in the assessment.

The house unanimously approved the minutes.

2. To approve the minutes of the meeting of the Standing Committee of Academic Council held on 5th September 2024.

The Member Secretary apprised the house that since one of the External Expert in the subject of Computer Science nominated by Academic Council declined the invitation to join the Board of Studies, there was an urgent need to nominate another expert on their Board of Studies as their BOS meeting was scheduled to take place in the month of September 2024. Hence a standing committee of Academic Council was constituted to nominate another member from the list of External Experts. Accordingly, the following External Expert was nominated:

4. To approve the amendment in B. Voc. Ordinance as per the new programme structure.

B.Voc. Ordinance is based on the National Credit Framework under NEP 2020 wherein the total number of credits for a 3-year Undergraduate Degree Programme in Bachelor of Vocation shall be 120 whereas for a 4-year Honors Programme in Vocation shall be 160 with multiple entry and multiple exits at First Year, Second Year and Third Year.

Resolution: Approved

5. To approve the internship policy.

Internships provide students with a clearer sense of their career aspirations. Through internships, students can explore different industries, roles, and work environments, helping them to refine their career goals and make more informed decisions about their future.

Earlier, the Internship and Placement Cell handled the internship process. However, with the integration of internship into the academic curriculum, there arose a need to establish a formal internship policy. This policy has been developed in accordance with the guidelines set forth by the University Grants Commission (UGC).

Resolution: Approved

6. To approve the policy for extra academic credits.

The extra credit policy has been in place previously. However, modifications have been made to the same to align with the National Education Policy (NEP). As per this policy, students are permitted to be enrolled for any of the additional courses from Discipline Specific Cores/Minor Stream/ Multidisciplinary Course/Skill Enhancement Course/Value Added Course/ Ability Enhancement Course that are being offered under the undergraduate programmes of Arts and Science of the college. Enrollment in these courses is subject to specific conditions. Students have the flexibility to take an unlimited number of extra credits, provided it fits within their academic timetable.

Resolution: Approved with the following suggestion:

i) An undertaking will be required from students, acknowledging that it is their sole responsibility to attend the lectures and the department will not be held responsible if students are unable to attend due to clash in timetable.

7. To approve the amendment to Postgraduate Degree Ordinance AO-5A regarding double the duration of PG programmes.

An amendment has been made to the Postgraduate Degree Ordinance AO-5A, which states: "The duration of the Postgraduate Degree Programme is 2 years (or 4 semesters). However, students may be permitted to complete the programme within a maximum duration of 4 years."

Resolution: Approved

Solution of Angelone Angelone

8. To approve the amendment to Undergraduate and Postgraduate Degree Ordinances regarding extension of double the duration.

A Special Ordinance SO-2 on extension of double duration, in view of the Covid pandemic for the B.A./B.Sc./B.VOC./M.A./M.Sc. students who have not obtained the Under/Post Graduate Degree was formulated in line with Goa University Ordinance.

Resolution: Approved

9. To approve part amendment to Ordinance AO-20.8 relating to award of entitlement marks and grace marks at the Semester End Examination.

Goa University has made a partial amendment to its Ordinance OA-5.16, and in alignment with this change, the college has amended its existing Ordinance AO-20.8 in accordance with Goa University's respective Ordinance.

Resolution: Approved and will be applied to students from next semester (even semester), provided it is approved in the Governing Body meeting.

10. Any Other Business (A.O.B.)

The Member Secretary informed the house that during the previous Academic Council meeting, an amendment regarding the calculation of workload for dissertations in the PG Ordinance AO-5A was discussed. However, it was decided that further deliberation would take place at the IQAC level before it is presented in Academic Council. Accordingly, this agenda was presented for discussion at the meeting.

Amendment in PG Ordinance AO-5A.4: "The DFC shall decide the number of students each teacher can guide with an equitable distribution of students to Guides for sharing the workload. Such workload shall be computed as four hours per week for 3 to 8 students and two hours per week for less than 3 students"

Resolution: Approved with the suggestion:

i) The dissertation shall be guided by the faculty with PhD qualifications only.

The meeting ended at 6.30 p.m. with a vote of thanks by the Chairperson of Academic Council.
